PENNY Gorgeous, bring in the three wise men.

RANDY (VO) I'm lucky she didn't smother me in my sleep.

INT. GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

Penny changes Randy's nappies whilst smoking a cigarette.

Grand comes beside her.

GRAND You're doing it all wrong, let me have it, you'll probably poke his bottom!

PENNY Go ahead.

Penny lights a cigarette and walks away.

INT. GRAND'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Grand holding Randy.

She looks out and sees Penny being dropped off by a red car.

Montage. Penny gets dropped by a blue car.

INT. GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

PENNY (CONT'D) I have to take this, its Mark. (on the phone) Hey Mark! I meant Daniel, hey Daniel!

Penny gets up and leaves.

INT. HOUSE - LIVING ROOM

RANDY (VO) I got whooped at school, because of my low grades. I got whooped at the house, because of ma's low grade drugs.

(CONTINUED)

Randy (8) being beaten mercilessly by his mother, Grand holds her back and Randy manages to escape.

RANDY (VO) I got so good at running. The only thing I ever won in my life was a sport's medal for 100m sprint.

JOHN (VO) Want some dope?

RANDY (VO) No, I'm good. But it all changed when Grand died.

EXT. GRAVE SITE - DAY

MOURNERS gathered. Penny and Randy (13) cry.

Penny hugs Randy close and nearly smothers.

RANDY (VO) With Grand gone, I knew I was history. Penny brought her boyfriends home and...

INT. GRAND'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Randy sits in front of the television.

Penny comes in with a strange MAN (50).

PENNY Voesek! Go to bed you little brat.

Randy stands up and leaves whilst Penny drunkenly falls onto the sofa with the strange man.

EXT. DOOR-STEP GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

Randy arrives home. Penny looks at her watch.

PENNY I told you to come home by seven.

Penny smacks Randy.

INT. LIVING ROOM GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

Randy shows Penny his report card, a chain of Fs.

PENNY Useless. Stupid. Ass-hole.

Penny smacks Randy.

RANDY (VO) That's what USA meant to me.

INT. KITCHEN, GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

Randy arrives home with the groceries. Penny raises a jar of milk.

PENNY I said condensed. Condensed!

Penny smacks Randy.

INT. DINING ROOM - DAY

RANDY (VO) I got hit just for about anything. But my biggest mistake was getting born.

JOHN (VO) U.S.A Useless, stupid ass-hole, go figure.

RANDY (VO) It wasn't all bad. Sometimes...

Strange Man gives Randy some money.

RANDY (VO) I saved up all the money I got until my mother found it under the mattress and stole it.

INT. BEDROOM, GRAND'S HOUSE - NIGHT
Randy looks under his mattress and sees nothing.

RANDY (VO) It wasn't safe in the womb, and it wasn't safe in the flat. So I go up out of there. INT. WINDOW, GRAND'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Randy (15) jumps through the window and goes out into the night. Sirens and gun shots ring out.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy looks up. Cloudy skies.

He puts his hood over his head, as it begins to rain.

Randy goes into an alley and sits down.

INT. KITCHEN, GRAND'S HOUSE - DAY

Tears fall down Penny's eyes, she rubs them away.

She continues to cut her onions.

A strange MAN (43) enters the kitchen.

MAN No sign of the little man.

PENNY I hope he comes back. My welfare cheque depends on that son of a...

EXT. ALLEY WAY - NIGHT

Randy sees PROSTITUTES distributing their product. Cars stop and talk to them.

Randy feels something, he looks down and sees a rat. He sighs.

A voice speaks to him.

BOY Give me your money.

Randy looks up and sees an older BOY (19).

The boy tugs at the bag.

Randy gets up and runs.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Randy looks through some garbage bins.

RANDY (VO) I soon got tired of eating out of the garbage, though my ma's cooking was exactly that.

John laughs off screen.

RANDY (VO) I would have begun my criminal career much sooner but...

EXT. PARK BENCH - DAY

A MAN (24) with handcuffs runs through the CROWD.

POLICE chase after the man on bicycles.

The man falls down in front of Randy as he sits on the bench.

The police rush him and beat him.

RANDY (VO) I think they broke his rib cage, besides people cracking jokes I'm sure I heard something else crack.

EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Randy begins directing parking cars for a living.

Some white DRIVER gives him a coin.

RANDY Thank you ma'am.

Randy jiggles the coins in his pocket.

EXT. PARK BENCH - NIGHT

Randy sleeps on the bench, a knife moves on to his throat. Randy opens his eyes and looks up.

A BOY (13) searches Randy's pockets and takes out the coins.

The boy flees into the night.

RANDY (VO) Money that I spent weeks saving, he made in a couple of minutes.

EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Randy continues his parking job.

RANDY (VO) I was beginning to think about leaving the straight and narrow. Then I met Big Ben.

A red convertible parks in front of Randy. BIG BEN (21) a short biracial muscular man comes out of the car. A young beautiful GIRL (16) comes out of the other side.

BIG BEN Wash it for me kid.

Big Ben flips Randy a coin.

Big Ben leaves.

Randy begins to clean the car.

EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Big Ben and his tall girlfriend come back. Big Ben whistles.

BIG BEN As clean as a whistle.

The convertible sparkles.

Big Ben hands Randy a note.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) I wish my little cousins could take note.

RANDY I'll take <u>this</u> note. EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Montage. Big Ben parks a white car, he comes out with a white GIRL (16).

Big Ben parks a black car, he comes out with a black GIRL (16).

Big Ben parks a yellow car, he comes out with an Asian GIRL (16).

EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Big Ben parks a brown car, he comes out with a biracial GIRL (16).

Randy whistles.

BIG BEN That's my cousin sister, idiot.

RANDY

Sorry.

Big Ben flips Randy a coin. Big Ben looks Randy over.

BIG BEN You look like...

A BOY (11) snatches the Big Ben's cousin's purse and runs. Randy pursues him.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy keeps chasing.

RANDY (VO) I knew those streets like the back of my hand.

Randy catches him and gets the purse, the boy gets up and runs.

EXT. PARKING LOT - DAY

Randy comes back with the purse.

BIG BEN (to his cousin) What did I tell you about, not being alert, it's all that weed. (to Randy) Thanks, boy can you run.

Randy gives Big Ben the purse.

RANDY (VO) After that, Big Ben started treating me like his kid brother.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - DAY

Montage. Big Ben points to the bathroom. He hands Randy some soap and a towel.

Randy in new clothes looking into a big mirror.

Randy wolfing down a big meal whilst Big Ben and his cousin sister look on.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - DAY

RANDY (VO) I don't what it was about Big Ben but he liked his things big, except his women of course.

Randy sits in a big chair looking at a big screen television.

INT. GYMNASIUM - DAY

RANDY (VO) He introduced me to gym.

Randy lies under some iron bars struggling to get it off.

BIG BEN Hey Jim, help the kid.

JIM (23) biracial man gets the iron bar off Randy.

INT. CLUB - NIGHT

RANDY (VO) Big Ben showed me a good time.

Big Ben sits with Randy on couches. Big Ben gives Randy a watch.

Big Ben has two GIRLS on each of his arms.

BIG BEN

Take one.

Randy and the girl dance.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - NIGHT

RANDY (VO) Big Ben opened doors for me.

Big Ben opens the door and Randy is standing with a pizza in a pizza suit.

BIG BEN Hey! It's the pizza man. I meant the pizza not your face. Smile, the customer's always beautiful.

Randy hands Big Ben the pizza.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) How do you like your new job?

RANDY It's better than washing cars.

Big Ben gives Randy some money.

BIG BEN

I'm hurt. Do you wanna know what I had to do to get you that licence and this job?

RANDY

Sure.

BIG BEN If I told you, I'd have to bribe you too, to keep quiet.

EXT. DRIVE WAY - NIGHT

Randy goes down the stairs and into a car with PIZZA DELIVERY on the roof.

Randy changes his clothes and puts on a clown's outfit.

RANDY (VO) Things were changing.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

RANDY (VO) Things were starting to look up.

Randy starts the car and leaves.

EXT. DOOR STEPS - NIGHT

Montage. Randy delivering pizza to the doorstep of a skinny white TRACY (21).

Randy delivering pizza to the same girl, now fatter.

Randy delivering pizza to the same girl, now even fatter.

EXT. DOOR STEPS - NIGHT

Randy delivers pizza to fat Tracy.

RANDY I don't think this fast food isn't healthy.

TRACY Healthy? And who the hell are you?

Tracy grabs the pizza.

TRACY (CONT'D) You're just a pizza boy.

She slams the door in his face.

EXT. DOOR STEP - NIGHT

Randy delivers pizza to Tracy.

TRACY Do you really think I'm getting fat?

Randy looks her over and nods.

TRACY (CONT'D) Maybe you're right, come in.

Randy enters the flat.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

TRACY

Sit.

Randy sits down. Tracy sits next to him, she opens up the pizza box.

TRACY (CONT'D) It's just that, I'm a bad cook. And since my ma and pa divorced, I live with my pa and he... he...

Tracy begins to cry.

RANDY Are you ok?

TRACY Stupid pizza boy, do I look like I'm ok?

Tracy wipes her tears whilst gorging on some pizza.

RANDY (VO) Tracy told how her father was abusing her. How she was abusing herself. And also how much she liked me, which would explain the pizza.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

The pizza is designed as a heart.

Randy sits with Tracy on the sofa. Tracy feeds Randy pizza as he reclines.

RANDY (VO) And so began my first love affair. Also helped with the money part. Until...

JOHN (VO) Was she still fat?

She wasn't fat, just curvy. Things were cool until... INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT Tracy takes the pizza and throws it away. TRACY He did it again! Randy he did it again! Tracy screams. RANDY Calm down. Randy holds Tracy. TRACY Calm down? You're my boyfriend, if it wasn't for that sleaze you would be my first. Tracy gets away from Randy. TRACY (CONT'D) Get rid off him. RANDY What? Big Ben starts to laugh. Tears flow down his cheeks. BIG BEN I hope you mean toy gun, the one that squirts water. RANDY I'm serious, I can't go into the details. Big Ben begins to eat the orange. BIG BEN You're serious?

Big Ben gives him a small pistol.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) Hope you don't want to solve a headache.

Big Ben points the gun to his head.

RANDY No. I'll go when they send for me, and they'll have to drag me when they come and get me.

Randy looks at he guns. He takes the biggest.

BIG BEN Compensating are we?

RANDY Look who's talking.

Randy points the gun to Big Ben's shorts.

EXT. BACK ALLEY - NIGHT

Big Ben and Randy stand in front of beer bottles.

Big shoots the bottles perfectly.

RANDY Still won't tell me what you do for a living?

Big Ben begins loading the gun whilst Randy puts new bottles.

BIG BEN I make a killing, pay my bills, pay my taxes, most of the time but I never pay my women.

Big Ben gives Randy the gun.

RANDY

You don't?

Randy takes aim.

BIG BEN I just pay attention.

Randy misses all the bottles.

RANDY I'm not going after beer bottles, I won't miss.

BIG BEN Just wear your gloves, and dump Susie after use. Just like your condoms.

Big Ben leave the alley.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

They walk in the ghetto.

RANDY You give your guns names?

Big Ben looks at his arms.

BIG BEN Peter and Paul, they'll discipline you. Just be careful and if it all goes amiss like in the alley, my connections will serve and protect you.

INT. CLOSET, TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Randy hides in the closet.

He sees Tracy sitting on the bed.

Sound of steps. The door opens.

TRACY'S FATHER (40) walks in.

TRACY'S FATHER You been smoking again?

TRACY

No.

TRACY'S FATHER Don't lie to me, I can smell the...

Tracy's father walks to the window. He closes the window shutters.

TRACY'S FATHER (CONT'D) Opening the windows.

He walks over the closet.

TRACY'S FATHER (CONT'D) All the clothes your mother buys you, the pocket money, spoiling you.

Tracy's father turns to Tracy and begins to take off his belt.

TRACY'S FATHER (CONT'D) But me, I won't spare the rod.

Randy comes out of the closet.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Tracy shows Randy the bills.

RANDY (VO) But Tracy really loved me, maybe because back then my face reminded her of pizza.

JOHN (VO) Rough. Know how that feels, wasn't too lucky with the girls though.

EXT. DOOR STEP - NIGHT

Montage. Randy delivers pizza to some TEENAGERS having a party.

Randy delivers pizza to some MOURNERS in black.

Randy delivers pizza to a COUPLE in formal wear.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

RANDY (VO) The pizza thing wasn't working, Tracy was doing night school and working at the pizza place.

Randy opens a can of beans. Sound of knocking.

TRACY It's the landlord.

Randy puts a finger to his lips. The knocking persists for a little while and stops.

TRACY (CONT'D) Randy, what are we gonna do?

INT. JOHN'S HOUSE - DAY - REAL TIME

John types for a while as Randy sits.

JOHN That's one hell of a story. That would be the end of like act one.

Sound of a car.

JOHN (CONT'D) She's back, probably with some food, you're probably starved.

RANDY Aren't you hungry to hear more?

JOHN I am, I am.

The young woman comes in, with some pizza.

WOMAN Dinner is served.

She puts the pizza boxes on the table. She kisses John on the cheek.

WOMAN (CONT'D) (to Randy) Hello, stranger, you look familiar, I think I seen you on tv.

JOHN It's work.

WOMAN You're the former gangster! JOHN He's not signing autographs.

WOMAN Can I stay, please?

JOHN It's up to you, Randy.

RANDY Why not. You remind me of someone in my distant past.

The woman begins putting the pizza in plates.

She reaches into the fridge and takes some beer cans.

Randy shakes his head but digs into his pizza, his phone rings.

RANDY (on the phone) Dolly, it's taking longer than I thought. Yeah, you might have to take the kids from Grand. I didn't wanna be rude. Bye.

Randy puts the phone into his pocket.

The woman nudges John.

WOMAN John and I are eternally grateful you've take the time to share your story.

JOHN We are? We are. Continue your heart gripping story.

EXT. DOOR STEP - NIGHT - FLASHBACK

Randy stands outside a door. It opens.

RANDY (VO) So what did I do?

Randy gives the pizza to the MAN (19).

The door closes.

RANDY (VO) Actually before that I...

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - NIGHT

Big Ben is sitting in his chair, while Randy kneels in front of him.

RANDY I need your help...

INT. PIZZA CUSTOMER'S HOUSE - NIGHT The man opens the pizza box and sees a packet of marijuana.

> RANDY (VO) I did what a man had to do.

EXT. DOOR STEP - NIGHT

Montage. Randy delivers pizza to some dread locked MEN.

Randy delivers pizza to some elderly WOMAN (69), Randy raises his eyebrows.

Randy delivers pizza to some TEENAGERS.

Randy delivers pizza to some MOURNERS.

Randy delivers pizza to some NEWLYWEDS.

EXT. DOOR STEP - NIGHT

Randy delivers pizza to a tattoed MAN.

RANDY (VO) Sometimes I got the orders wrong.

As Randy leaves the door opens.

TATTOOED MAN (OS) What is this doing there?

Randy turns slowly.

TATOOED MAN (CONT'D) I said I want pizza with pepper, now take this back.

Randy gets back the pizza.

RANDY (VO) And life was alright.

JOHN (VO) Not another montage.

WOMAN (VO) What's a montage?

JOHN (VO) It's a series of shots that condense time and information.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Randy cooking by the stove, then dishing out the food.

Randy and Tracy eating.

Tracy cooking, then dishing.

Randy eats and makes a face.

Tracy stirs and lets Randy eats, Randy smiles.

INT. KITCHEN, TRACY'S FLAT - DAY

Randy is cooking in the kitchen, the phone rings.

RANDY Tracy, the phone.

The ringing stops.

TRACY (OS) I told you to stop calling!

Tracy cuts the phone. She walks in.

RANDY Your mother again?

TRACY

Yup.

Randy stops stirring. He turns and holds Tracy close.

RANDY Your mother loves you. She might hate the thought of me and you but she loves you. Tracy rubs her hand through Randy's hair.

TRACY She wants me to leave you and come back home.

Randy dips the spoon into the pot and gives Tracy to eat.

RANDY Maybe if you talk her into coming over and trying my quisine she might like me.

TRACY

Forget it.

Randy eats from the spoon.

RANDY It's that bad?

TRACY

No, alright, I'll give her an ultimatum, me and you or her and Fritzie the dog.

RANDY She's just lonely that's all.

Tracy begins placing the dishes on the table.

TRACY Speaking of mothers how's your...

Randy turns his back.

RANDY I don't wanna talk about it.

INT. GARAGE - NIGHT

Randy walks in, cars are all around and mechanics working on them. Hip hop music rings out.

Big Ben comes from under a car.

BIG BEN Just the man I was looking for.

Big Ben gets up and looks under the bonnet of the car.

RANDY I got your message, what's this all about?

BIG BEN

Well...

KATRINA black (21) comes from nowhere and hugs Big Ben with his greases.

KATRINA

Big Ben!

BIG BEN Darling, I want you to meet Randy, Randy this is Katrina.

Randy extends his hand, Katrina hugs him.

KATRINA Any friend of Benny is a friend of mine.

Big Ben places a hand around Katrina, he pats her on the back as she leaves.

RANDY She looks way too old for you.

Big Ben goes under the hood.

BIG BEN 21, yeah a little too old for me but hey I'm getting on, I need a mature woman.

Big Ben shrugs.

RANDY So what did you send me for?

Big Ben erects himself.

BIG BEN I need a favour.

RANDY Just name it, I got your back.

BIG BEN You deliver pizza right? Right. I want you to be my delivery boy. Big Ben goes to the trunk of a car. He takes out a small sack.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) If you know what's good for you, you won't look. Just take it to this place.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

A bearded MAN (24) with tattooer gets inside.

MAN

Randy nods his head.

MAN (CONT'D) Where's the stuff?

Randy reaches into the back and takes out the small sack. The man looks into it, nods and gets out.

Randy drives away.

EXT. ROAD SIDE - NIGHT

Randy stands next to a car.

RANDY (VO) And the parcels got a bigger.

A MAN (30) comes and stands next to Randy. Randy gives him a suitcase.

EXT. ALLEY WAY - NIGHT

Randy stands in the street.

RANDY (VO) And bigger.

TWO MEN (40) comes and one whispers into Randy's ear.

Randy points to the alleyway. The two men carry a trunk into the night.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy parks the car. He gets out and another man gets in.

RANDY (VO) Sometimes I just left the car. And Big Ben also helped me out with the dollars. But Big Ben...Big Ben had his women problems. Katrina.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - DAY

Katrina blows Big Ben a kiss.

RANDY (VO) One minute it was luvy dovey.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - NIGHT

Katrina throws a cup at Big Ben.

RANDY (VO) The next minute it was Ike and Tina Turner, or Mike and Robin, or OJ, before he whacked his wifey. Katrina, Randy and Big Ben walk in the street with bags.

Katrina looks at some guy who passes by.

BIG BEN Who you looking at?

KATRINA What now, I can't even look at people?

Katrina throws down the bags.

KATRINA (CONT'D) Just because you pay my bills, my hair, my clothes and my little brother's fees don't mean you tell me what to do!

Katrina turns and begins to walk away.

BIG BEN Come back! Don't turn your back on me Trina, you don't walk away from me, I walk away from you.

Big Ben and Randy picks up the bags and goes into the opposite direction.

RANDY (VO) I had never seen Big Ben so hung up. And me, it was time to meet my mother in law.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - DAY

Tracy and Randy are busy cleaning up. A door knock rings out.

TRACY

It's her.

Tracy and Randy go and open the door, Randy lets Tracy open it.

TATOOED MAN (CONT'D)

Mom.

Lorraine (61) stands by the door way.

LORRAINE May I come in?

She enters.

RANDY Of course you may.

INT. DINNER TABLE - NIGHT

Randy, Tracy and Lorraine all sit and eat.

LORRAINE So you're happy?

Tracy pours herself some soup. She smiles.

TRACY Read my lips. Some cheese?

Lorraine shakes her head.

LORRAINE (to Randy) Are you happy?

Randy looks up whilst eating, he nods.

Lorraine puts her fork down.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Well I'm not. Tracy, I...your father...I might have hated that man, but I loved him.

TRACY Then why did you divorce him then?

LORRAINE You would never understand.

Tracy collects some of the empty plates.

TRACY I'm glad he's dead.

Lorraine eyes Randy.

LORRAINE So they never found the killer? Typical. The police just sit and pretend. Tracy takes the plates and leaves.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) (to Randy) You and I need to talk. In private.

Randy nods.

EXT. PARK - DAY

Lorraine and Randy walk in the park.

LORRAINE You're one hell of a cook?

RANDY

I fry.

LORRAINE Your mother taught you that?

RANDY My mother taught me to run. Real fast.

They stop by a lake, CYCLISTS rush past.

LORRAINE Where is she now?

Randy shrugs.

RANDY Don't know, don't care.

LORRAINE I bet that's what the police say about my ex-husband.

Lorraine looks at Randy and holds his arm.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) What happened to my ex-husband?

Randy removes her hand.

RANDY

I...

LORRAINE You're playing with fire. RANDY

Excuse me?

Randy walks to a bench and sits.

RANDY (CONT'D) What are you getting at?

Lorraine walks over to him.

LORRAINE I think Tracy killed him.

Randy sighs.

She sits next to him.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Leave her, she's poison.

A MAN (75) sits next to them and begins to feed pigeons.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) My husband had his faults, but he didn't deserve to die.

RANDY I never met the man, so.

Randy shrugs.

LORRAINE Your mother had her faults but...

Randy stands and goes to the pond. Lorraine comes and stands next to him.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Forgiveness, I wish I...I cheated on my husband.

The pigeon feeder looks up.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) He forgave me but I wasn't in love with him. But he loved me, he loved Tracy.

Randy swallows hard.

RANDY I bet he did, but that's all water under the bridge now. Randy throws a stone into the water. LORRAINE Whatever happened to my husband, you and Tracy, I just have to let it go.

Lorraine grabs Randy.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Whatever your mother did to you, let it go.

Randy throws another stone into the water.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) But about Tracy. Watch out, I know her.

INT. CAR - DAY

Lorraine drives whilst Randy is in the passenger's seat.

RANDY I don't think this is a good idea.

LORRAINE It's a great idea.

RANDY Turn left.

Lorraine turns the car.

RANDY (CONT'D) Right here.

Lorraine stops.

LORRAINE

Well.

Randy folds his arms.

Lorraine opens the door and gets out.

EXT. DOOR STEP - DAY

Lorraine crosses the road.

A dog urinates by the door step. DRUNKARDS lies in the gutter. Sound of gun shots.

Lorraine knocks on the door.

BILL biracial (45) opens the door.

BILL What you doing around here?

Lorraine tightens her grip on her purse.

LORRAINE I'm looking for Penny.

Bill opens the door.

BILL

Penny!

Lorraine looks in, she sees PENNY lying on the floor with one hand on a bottle of gin. TOD (4) cries as he sits on the floor next to his mother.

> LORRAINE Give me one minute.

Bill shuts the door.

INT. CAR - DAY

Lorraine shuts the door.

RANDY What did I tell you?

Lorraine shuffles in the dashboard, she gets a box of cigarettes and lights one.

RANDY (CONT'D) You smoke?

LORRAINE I quit, trying to...I get your point. You grew up here?

Lorraine shivers. Randy plays with the gear stick.

RANDY Can we go now? Lorraine puffs desperately. LORRAINE Who's the kid? BILL (OS) Tod! Don't play with that! RANDY Who? LORRAINE Tod. EXT. DOOR STEP - DAY Randy knocks on the door, Bill answers. BILL What do you want? Randy looks in and sees Penny still passed out. INT. PENNY'S HOUSE - DAY Penny is still on the floor. Bill holds Tod in his arms. Randy and Lorraine sit on the couch. BILL It's just Tod, me and your mother. RANDY How does she treat Tod? BILL She has her weaknesses. Randy looks at Penny then takes Tod. RANDY Every week. There's no way Tod is staying in this hell hole. BILL Ay wait a minute... Bill grabs Tod.

LORRAINE They can come and stay with you and Tracy.

RANDY Ay wait a minute...

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Penny sits in the back of the car, whilst Lorraine drives, Randy sits in the passenger with Tod sitting in his lap.

> PENNY So after all this time you bring your useless behind back.

LORRAINE No need for that kind of your talk, he's your son.

RANDY Remember, I'm doing this for Tod.

Penny lights a cigarette and smokes.

PENNY

Guess you're not so useless, we're bout to starve back there, Bill does alright as a guard.

RANDY Tod, everything we'll be alright, and Penny if you ever lay a finger on him...

PENNY Don't tell me what to do...

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

The car drives on whilst the two shout at each other, then it stops and makes a U-turn.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

The car stops, Penny emerges from the car.

PENNY

Give him to me! Now! He's mine.

Penny reaches in and takes Tod. The car then drives off.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy is driving, while Lorraine smokes.

LORRAINE And I thought I was a bad mother.

RANDY I'll have to chip in and give them a hand, wish I could just give her a back hand.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Lorraine and Randy walk into the flat.

Tracy is sitting on the couch, smoking a cigarette.

RANDY You'll never believe who we met...

TRACY You'll never believe what I have to tell you.

Tracy pats the sofa, Lorraine and Randy sit.

TRACY Looks like I got a bun in the oven.

Randy stands up, tears flow down his face.

TRACY (CONT'D) Don't look so happy, what will we feed him, love. I'm thinking of having an abor...

RANDY Don't you even finish that sentence.

LORRAINE I can help out...

Randy raises up Tracy and holds her close.

RANDY I'll figure something out, don't you worry. INT. GARAGE - DAY

Randy walks into the garage full of mechanics and Big Ben in the back office.

RANDY (VO) But she had plenty to be worried about.

Randy enters the office.

Big Ben has his legs on the table, whilst on the phone, he gestures to Randy to seat down, then after some laughter cuts the phone.

BIG BEN That was Katrina, we're back together.

RANDY You had split up?

Big Ben looks at the newspaper.

BIG BEN Hills and valleys.

Randy stands up and looks back at the workshop.

RANDY Speaking of valleys. I found my mother.

BIG BEN You never talk about her, how is she?

RANDY

Worse.

BIG BEN She was sick.

Big Ben throws down the newspaper.

RANDY No, anyway, I got a kid brother, and a baby on the way.

Big Ben stands up and extends his hand, Randy hesitates and takes his hand.

BIG BEN

Congrats.

RANDY Rats indeed. Well that's why I'm here, I need work.

BIG BEN

Sure.

Randy sits down.

RANDY I mean real work, real money.

Big Ben also sits down.

BIG BEN You're a good kid, I don't wanna see you knee dip in...

RANDY Delivering pizza, suitcases and weed, will never pay... you've gotta help me out man.

BIG BEN You have no real work experience, no CV, but I will concur with the Judge. We'll call you.

INT. TRACY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Randy is sleeping, Tracy next to him. The phone rings. Randy picks it up.

RANDY Alright, I'll be there.

Randy gets out of bed.

TRACY What's up?

RANDY Nothing, go to bed. INT. DOOR WAY - NIGHT

As Randy leaves, Lorraine stands from the couch in the darkness.

LORRAINE Be careful out there, your son needs a father.

RANDY Who ever got hurt running errands.

Randy goes to her and kisses her on the cheek, he then leaves.

EXT. CLUB - NIGHT

A group of young MEN stumble out of a club.

MAN Birthday boy, didn't your mama send you for some tomatoes or something?

VICTOR Tomorrow, tomorrow, I'm too drunk.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Big Ben is in the driver's seat, next to him is Randy. In the back are two GOONS.

Big Ben hands Randy a pistol.

BIG BEN

Blood in.

RANDY

Blood out.

Randy takes the pistol and gets out of the car.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Randy runs to the group of men and points the pistol.

Victor freezes.

Randy fires three times, then runs back into the car. The car speeds away. EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Victor lays on the floor surrounded by his friends.

FRIEND Victor. Victor! Somebody call his mother!

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Big Ben drives the car laughing.

BIG BEN See that, froze like an ice cream on a hot day!

Randy toys nervously with the gun.

RANDY Yeah, like an ice cream on a hot day.

BIG BEN The Victor has has become the victim.

Big Ben takes the gun.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) You're now in, son your CV, that is Criminal Vitae is spotless and perfect...

Big Ben looks Randy over.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) Just one more thing though...

INT. GARAGE - DAY

Randy sits in a chair groaning while some MAN (23) plucks out his front teeth.

JOHN (VO) So those are fake? Give me your dentist's number quick.

Randy's arm is being tattooed.

42.

RANDY I'm gonna call my son Benjamin after you Ben, and if I have a daughter, I'll call her Winnie.

TATOOE GUY After Winnie the Pooh? Why!

RANDY

After the Mandela's wife, gees...

Randy looks at himself in the mirror without a shirt, he smiles and reveals his missing front teeth. Big Ben pats him on the back.

> BIG BEN The Young En Stupid Gang got your back now, it'll be raining money boy!

INT. GARAGE - NIGHT

Rain falls on the window.

A young black GIRL (10) is brought in screaming by some HOODS.

Big Ben sits in the chair his feet on the desk.

BIG BEN

Randy!

Randy comes in. Big Ben nods to one of the hoods.

The hood cuts of the girls little finger and puts it on the desk.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) Randy, your first job, deliver this...Give him the finger.

Randy nods and takes the finger.

INT. CAR - DAY

Randy drives the car, the finger in the dashboard, he stops at a fancy house.

EXT. GATE - DAY

Randy puts the finger in an envelope in the mail box.

JOHN (VO) Lucky, you didn't get fingered.

RANDY I felt bad, I felt good when the rich bastard took us seriously.

EXT. FOREST - DAY

MEN in masks hold the little girl.

A MAN (43) in overalls holds a suitcase, in the back ground is a crying WOMAN (45) and her HUSBAND (50) who holds her.

The overalls man hands over the suitcase and gets the girl.

INT. GARAGE - NIGHT

Big Ben opens the suitcase loaded with rands, he hands them over to the men all around.

RANDY (VO) That wasn't my last delivery.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy is driving in the car.

RANDY (VO) Sometimes, they didn't come up with the money fast enough...

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Randy dumps a body in the street.

INT. HOUSE - LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Randy and some hoods in a dark house.

RANDY (VO) My favourite story is the time we found a police uniform while doing some work. EXT. STREET - DAY Randy in a police out fit, robbing a MAN (29) who leans against the wall.

> RANDY (VO) It made my job a lot easier.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

The Cesspool club, PEOPLE getting in and out.

INT. CLUB - NIGHT

Randy and Big Ben in a club with girls.

RANDY (VO) Then there was the partying, boy did we party.

PEOPLE break dancing on the floor.

RANDY (VO) That's until the fighting started.

QUINCY (25) walks over Big Ben's shoe, the latter pushes him then a fight begins.

RANDY (VO) Quincy and his brother Vincent, young punk drug dealers...

INT. JAIL CELL - DAY

SQUEAKY CLEAN (29) smokes in prison.

RANDY (VO) If it wasn't for Squeaky Clean, some big shot General in the prison system...

A MAN (24) shines Squeaky Clean's shoes, Squeaky Clean nods.

RANDY (VO) Quincy and Vincent would be doing dirt, real dirt 6 feet under. EXT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - DAY

The ghetto with filth and squalor.

RANDY (VO) We moved back into the ghetto, closer to work.

INT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - DAY

Big screen tv. BOYS (19) and (15) playing video games on the tv. Big radio.

RANDY (VO) Plus, me with nice stuff in the suburbs would attract the wrong kind of attention.

INT. KITCHEN, RANDY'S FLAT - DAY

Randy is in the kitchen cooking. Tracy reads a magazine, her stomach has grown a bit bigger.

RANDY (VO) On the outside world things looked bad, at home we could afford nice things.

Tracy sighs and flips the magazine.

RANDY (VO) We weren't rich but soon enough, we would have our baby.

Tracy stands up and looks through the passageway.

TRACY When are they leaving?

Randy tastes his food.

RANDY They are my workmates...

TRACY And the tooth thing, I hate it, the tattooer are alright, especially the Tracy one with a rose and a thorn.

Randy gives her the spoon to taste.

RANDY Well you are a pain in my side.

Randy rubs her belly.

RANDY How's Benjamin?

TRACY We're not calling him after your friend, he calls in the middle on the night, you're never home, I'm lonely...

A knock on the door.

RANDY They're all here.

Randy leaves the room.

INT. DINING TABLE - DAY

Randy, Tracy, Big Ben and Katrina, Bill, Penny, Tod and some other gang members are at table.

They laugh and sing.

RANDY (VO) I did a lot of bad, but there were some good times.

INT. SHOP - DAY

Randy walks in with base ball bats accompanied by Jim, Big Ben and some other GOONS.

RANDY (VO) And there were bad times.

BIG BEN You still won't pay?

The SHOP OWNER (40) goes around the counter.

SHOP OWNER

Never.

Big Ben points the bat at the shop owner's face.

BIG BEN I'm letting you know right off the bat, you don't pay protection money, you'll be sorry.

Big Ben turns and walks out followed by his retinue.

INT. SHOP - NIGHT

Randy pouring diesel around the shop and lighting a match.

RANDY (VO) And he was, sorry that is.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy sits in the car next to Big Ben as the shop burns.

The car drives off.

RANDY (VO) After that the whole neighbourhood paid us to serve and protect.

EXT. BALCONY - DAY

Bill and Randy sit by the balcony. Music plays.

RANDY I don't know how you live with Penny.

BILL Everybody has their weaknesses.

Randy looks back into the house and sees Penny dancing with a pint of beer in her hands.

RANDY

So how's work?

BILL I'd been meaning to tell you about something... Randy and some other men open the pedlock of some storage facility.

INT. STORE ROOM - NIGHT

Randy has a torch, he looks around and sees computers, medicine and a safe.

RANDY

Jack pot.

EXT. BALCONY - DAY

Randy hands Bill some money.

RANDY (VO) Bill got fired soon afterwards, but I took care of them.

Randy looks back into the house.

RANDY (VO) Just wasn't happy about Tracy spending so much time with Penny, then I caught her red handed.

INT. BATHROOM - DAY

Randy walks in and finds Tracy shooting up tik.

RANDY (VO) The mother of my child...

Randy closes the door, sound of beating and screaming.

RANDY (VO) I had never hit a woman in my entire life before that.

INT. LIVING ROOM, RANDY'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Tracy sits on the couch with a swollen face, Randy next to her.

Lorraine looks at them both, she shrugs.

LORRAINE You were both wrong. You both need to exercise self control.

Lorraine pats Randy and stands up, Randy follows her.

INT. KITCHEN, RANDY'S FLAT - NIGHT

Lorraine lights a cigarette.

LORRAINE I hate to say this, but I warned you, just keep her away from your mother.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy sits on top of his car, Big Ben inside with some other hoods, Jim and JACK (21).

RANDY (VO) Tracy had to stay away from Quincy and his crew for selling blow.

A line is drawn on the tar mac.

On the other side is Quincy, Vincent and his crew.

RANDY I oughta kill em...

Big Ben lifts his shirt and shows a scar.

BIG BEN You control your woman, God knows I have enough trouble with Katrina. I want you to follow her, make sure she ain't doing anything, or anyone.

INT. CAR - DAY

Randy watches Katrina get into a car and leave, he follows her.

RANDY (VO) I followed all day. To the mall, her friend's house, the clinic, the hair salon, the market and back. INT. GARAGE - DAY

Big Ben sits on his desk, Randy on a chair.

RANDY You're just paranoid, Katrina might be crazy but she ain't crazy enough to cheat on you, you're the man.

Big Ben rubs his nose.

BIG BEN Yeah, but yo, I got bad news...

RANDY Don't tell me...

Randy stands up.

BIG BEN I spotted Tracy down at the drug spot.

Randy leaves in a huff.

INT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Tracy sits watching television, as soon as she hears a car, she puts out a cigarette. Sound of someone running up the stairs.

The door opens and in comes Randy, he points menacingly at her.

Tracy stands up and backs into the curtains.

Randy smacks her a good five hundred times.

TRACY I lost the baby!

Randy stops hitting her.

RANDY

You what?!

Tracy goes around him and sits on the couch, she looks around the papers and takes out a doctor's note.

TRACY Three weeks ago, I meant to tell you but... Randy takes out his gun, he points it at her, whilst breathing heavily. He then punches her and she falls down.

Randy walks out and bangs the door.

INT. BAR - NIGHT

Randy sits at the bar dowsing glass after glass.

BARTENDER I think you've had enough.

RANDY You're right, I've had enough of that wife of mine...Pour me another drink.

Randy puts a gun on the table. The bartender pours him another glass. Big Ben comes with Katrina and sits next to him.

> RANDY (CONT'D) Big Ben, help me out man, she lost the baby!

Randy begins to cry.

BIG BEN God no! Get up...

RANDY I'm not going anywhere, I wanna die...

Big Ben takes out his cellphone.

BIG BEN (on the cellphone) It's crunch time.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

A procession of cars stop by a house. Big Ben, Randy and some other goons get out and see Quincy and Vincent.

Big Ben takes out a chain and swings it aiming at Quincy whilst Randy hits Vincent with a base ball bat.

Quincy falls back and whistles.

Suddenly a host of THUGS come out of the house and onto the street.

52.

A fight breaks out. After a couple of minutes Quincy's crew runs away. Big Ben points his gun to the sky and fires. RANDY (VO) Kicking their asses made me feel a little better though I was still bitter, the gold chain helped too. INT. QUINCY'S HANG OUT - NIGHT Quincy stands in front of a young PUNK (26) RANDY (VO) From what I heard, Quincy punished the first to run. Quincy takes off his pants. QUINCY Take off your pants. The punk takes off his pants. QUINCY (CONT'D) Now bend over. Quincy takes out a condom. RANDY (VO) Don't look at me like that, I never. But that was Quincy. INT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - DAY Randy sits at the kitchen table holding Tracy's hand. RANDY I'm sorry, it could have happened to anybody. TRACY No I'm sorry, we can always try again. Randy hugs her.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy hides in the tall grass.

RANDY (VO) I put all my anger into work. Me and Jack, funny his name was Jack, did just that.

A car parks by the road side, a MAN (27) comes out and urinates in the bushes.

RANDY (VO) While he relieved himself, I relieved him of his car.

Randy and Jack get into the car and drive off.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Randy and Jack break open a car and steal it into the night.

RANDY (VO) Sometimes the car was there for the taking.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy is dragged off by a car with his shirt stuck inside.

RANDY (VO) And sometimes, they got away.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Randy is almost shot by a male DRIVER (33).

RANDY (VO) Sometimes they fought back...

Randy high tails back into his car and Jack drives off.

RANDY (VO) And it was my life on the line. Big Ben puts a chain around Randy's neck. Men stand around.

RANDY (VO) Soon, I got promoted to Teacher. Big was the General, Jim the Killer, Jack the Judge.

INT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - DAY

Randy takes a bag of money and puts it under the floor boards.

RANDY (VO) Just like a clever dog, I got to save for a rainy day.

Tod sneaks up on him, Randy turns around. Tod aims a toy gun at Randy.

RANDY Little man, you don't need that around here.

Randy picks him up.

TOD Are you taking me back to mama? I don't wanna.

Randy walks with him out into the kitchen.

INT. KITCHEN, RANDY'S FLAT - DAY

RANDY Me neither but my hands are tied, let me make you some lunch, ok.

Tracy is inside painting her toe nails.

TRACY Don't spoil him with all those toys.

RANDY Too many toys spoil the kids?

Randy puts Tod down and takes out some chips which he hands to the boy.

55.

TRACY That's why you're always getting in trouble at kindergarden.

TOD I never run away from a fight.

Tracy pulls her tongue at him.

TRACY No but you run away from a bath.

Sound of honking. Tracy goes to the window.

TRACY (CONT'D) It's your mother.

RANDY Tod, time's up. We'll play video games some other time.

Tod folds his hands, Randy carries him out.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - DAY

GOONS sit around counting money. Katrina sits with her arms folded.

Big Ben is on the other side of the sofa. Randy looks up from counting the money.

RANDY You two are not talking?

KATRINA I'm not talking to you either, you been following me again.

Tracy takes a pillow and hits Big Ben.

BIG BEN You're crazy, Randy tell her she's crazy.

RANDY You're both crazy.

KATRINA Plus, I know about Monique, Desirene, Patricia... BIG BEN Can't a man have friends?

Katrina folds her hands.

KATRINA But you don't sleep with your hooligans, now do you?

RANDY Whoa, I ain't Quincy...

Randy's cellphone rings, he stands up and leaves the room.

RANDY (0S) Tell me your joking!

Big Ben stops sweet talking Katrina.

Randy walks back in.

RANDY

It's Tod.

INT. HOSPITAL - DAY

Tod lies on the bed surrounded by his entire family and Lorraine is there too. Silence for quite sometime.

RANDY Penny, what kind of mother are you?!

Penny gulps down some cough medicine.

PENNY He got shot, what's the big deal? You shoot people.

Randy grabs Penny.

RANDY He ain't staying with you any more.

PENNY Bill you gonna let him take your boy, let him talk to me like this!

An uproar emerges, a NURSE (21) walks in.

NURSE Keep it down.

Silence for sometime.

BILL It's those drug dealers, Squeaky Clean's people...

RANDY Quincy did this?!

BILL Penny, maybe the boy should stay with Randy for a while.

PENNY Fine, Randy doesn't even give his mother a little money, I have to drink cough medicine.

RANDY That's because you're an alcoholic!

The uproar comes back and so does the nurse, the whole room goes quiet.

EXT. BEACH - DAY

CHILDREN of different races play in the ocean, Tod is in the water.

Lorraine and Randy sit by the beach.

RANDY I'm glad you came.

LORRAINE When I heard the news, I rushed over.

Lorraine puts a hand on Randy.

RANDY Hope I didn't make you smoke.

LORRAINE

I quit, for now.

Lorraine takes out a popsicle, she hands one to Randy.

RANDY

I can't even swim, but I'm glad are swam out my mother's belly. Believe she wanted to have an abortion.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Kids are a precious gift, I'm so sorry about the miscarriage. I was too sick to come around.

RANDY But you called, so...

LORRAINE You should come to church with me...

Randy laughs.

RANDY The holy water would start boiling.

LORRAINE It's not too late to turn back.

A little white GIRL (9) runs past.

LORRAINE

Tracy used to be such a sweet girl, til she turned 13. Unlucky number. She stayed out late, hung around men old enough to be her father.

Lorraine looks at a MAN (43) with his daughter.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) And my husband beat the hell out of her. So much so, that one time Tracy hired some boyfriend to try and kill him.

Angle on Randy's face, his heart beats faster and faster.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) But the kid was a punk, didn't have it in him, told my husband. My infidelities made things worse...

Randy breathes heavily.

The GUIDE (29) blows his whistle.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) Are you alright..?

Randy jerks foward, whilst Lorraine nudges him. Randy swallows hard.

RANDY It's nothing...

LORRAINE Keep an eye on her, she's got her demons.

Randy looks out into the ocean and sees Tod gleeful.

Tod waves at him as he emerges from the waves.

INT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Randy sits facing Tracy whilst Tod is beside him wrestling a bone.

Randy stares at Tracy.

Tracy looks up, and raises her eyebrows.

TRACY What? Do I have mustard on my face?

Tracy strokes her face.

Randy shrugs.

RANDY Nothing. Tod how's the food?

Tod looks up from his bone and nods, Randy smiles.

RANDY (CONT'D) Trace, you going to work tomorrow?

TRACY The mall, yeah sure I have a shift.

Randy takes his plate and goes to the sink.

TRACY (CONT'D) What's the matter? It's so unlike you not to finish your food.

Randy shrugs.

RANDY (VO) Something smelt fishy, and it definitely wasn't the fish.

INT. CAR - DAY

Randy sits in a car.

Tracy gets out of the apartment and into her car.

As Tracy leaves Randy follows her.

RANDY (VO) I had my suspicions after talking to Lorraine, I guess love is not only blind but stupid.

INT. CAR - DAY

Randy sits in the car watching Tracy drop off Tod at school.

Tracy gives Tod some money, Tod rubs his fingers and Tracy gives him more, then more. Tracy gets into the car and goes off.

> RANDY (VO) I spent the whole day following this broad, changing cars until...

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy sits in the car whilst Tracy gets into some ware house.

Randy looks at his watch, an hour passes.

As Randy is about to doze off, he sees Tracy come out with Quincy.

Tracy and Vincent get into the car and drive off.

Randy starts the car and it stalls for a moment while Randy screws his face in anger, then finally he follows them.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Vincent and Tracy stop at a park, and Vincent turns off the engine.

Vincent lights Tracy's cigarette and they begin to talk inaudibly.

The rear view mirror shows a car parked some distance beyond.

As Tracy giggles and Vincent is about to kiss her, Randy comes to the side of the car and points his gun.

He shatters the glass with the gun, opens the door and drags Vincent out. Randy begins beating Vincent, over and over whilst Tracy screams.

Tracy tries to stop Randy and Randy gives her a back hand.

Randy reaches down and grabs Vincent.

RANDY You no good son of a...

Randy shakes Vincent but Vincent is dead, Randy shakes him again.

TRACY Oh my God he's dead?!

Randy and Tracy hoist the dead body and put it into the trunk.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy drives whilst Tracy sits beside him.

TRACY What are you gonna do?

RANDY Get rid of lover boy, then you.

Tracy opens the door of the moving vehicle.

RANDY (CONT'D) I'm not gonna kill you.

Tracy closes the door.

RANDY (CONT'D) It's over between us, I just want you to tell me everything. Everything.

Tracy lights a cigarette.

TRACY I...never had any feelings for him, I just wanted blow, that's all, I love you...

Tracy grabs Randy and Randy nearly swerves off the street.

RANDY Watch it. I talked to Lorraine, said you tried to off your father before.

TRACY She's lying...

Randy bangs the steering wheel.

RANDY Don't lie to me!

TRACY Alright, alright. My father never did what I said. But he beat me every day.

RANDY No wonder. What else, why did you give Tod so much money?

TRACY You were following me?! The little brat caught me with Vincent, I had to shut him up....police.

Randy looks into the rear view mirror and sees police.

RANDY Play it cool.

EXT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy takes back his driver's licence.

RANDY Don't arrest me officer, just give me a rest.

POLICE OFFICER Let me take a look around.

RANDY Go ahead officer.

The OFFICER (21) looks around and goes to the boot, where he sees a blanket hanging out. He looks at it. As he reaches down to take a look at it, his phone rings.

OFFICER ON THE OTHER LINE Emergency, emergency, homicide over at Parkins Street.

OFFICER Roger that. (to Randy).You can go. And fix that window.

Randy gets back into car.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Randy and Tracy walk onto deserted patch. Randy carrying shovels, he hands one to Tracy.

RANDY Just like our first date, except this time we're not digging into ice cream.

EXT. FOREST - NIGHT

Randy and Tracy dump the body into the ground.

EXT. CAR DUMP - NIGHT

Randy leaves the car at the car dump.

EXT. CAR DUMP - DAY

A car is being crushed by a machine.

EXT. RANDY'S APARTMENT - DAY

Tracy carries bags. Randy stares from inside the flat, with Tod hanging to his arm.

RANDY You going back to your mother?

TRACY

Yeah, I'll probably do that.

Randy digs into his trousers and takes out some money, he throws it to her.

The money lands on the floor, Tracy picks it up, when she looks up the door is closing.

She mouths 'bye' and walks away.

INT. GYMNASIUM - DAY

Weights are being lifted, up and down. Jack, Jim and Randy are standing around.

JIM One hundred and 99, Big you need to take it easy now.

Jim leans to take the steel bars.

BIG BEN

Leave it.

Big Ben continues pumping iron.

JACK Randy, heard about the missus.

RANDY Move on or move out. She moved out, I moved on.

Big Ben stops and gets up, Jack goes under the bars.

RANDY (CONT'D) Big Ben, no wise words?

Big Ben shrugs. Jim passes a cigarette, Big Ben shakes his head, he stands up and goes to a bag and takes out some oranges.

BIG BEN

Want one?

RANDY I hate oranges, ever since I watched the Godfather. So you don't smoke no more?

Big Ben leaves, eating the orange.

RANDY (CONT'D) What's eating him?

JIM Katrina's been sick, she's in the hospital.

RANDY He didn't even tell me...

Big Ben comes back in with some skipping ropes.

Jack gets off the bench and Jim begins hoisting the iron bars.

JACK Randy, did I tell you about the lady that I was loving.

Big Ben begins skipping.

JACK (CONT'D) Wanted her husband dead. One week later, husband comes around here saying he's tired of life, but couldn't do himself in.

RANDY What happened?

JACK

I got a bonus, both of them paid me. When I ran up on the hubby by his place looked like he didn't wanna die no more.

RANDY

Yeah?

JACK (CONT'D) But he had already paid me, no refunds.

Jack and Jimmy start laughing.

Big Ben stops skipping, he begins packing.

JACK (CONT'D) Where you going?

BIG BEN Going to the hospital.

RANDY I'm coming with you.

Randy and Big Ben leave.

INT. CAR - DAY

Big Ben drives whilst Randy sits in the passengers seat.

Silence for quite sometime. Randy reaches and turns on the system. Randy nods his head.

RANDY Are you feeling it?!

Big Ben turns off the radio. Silence for sometime.

RANDY (CONT'D) Come on cheer up.

Big Ben turns and smiles.

BIG BEN How's that? You happy now?

Randy puts his hand out of the window.

RANDY Katrina will be fine.

INT. HOSPITAL - NIGHT

Katrina lies on the hospital bed. Randy puts some flowers and fruits on the table.

RANDY Brought you your favourite, daffodils.

Big Ben sits down and holds her hand.

BIG BEN Kay, I called your mother, she'll be here tomorrow.

Katrina weakly nods.

KATRINA

Water.

BIG BEN Randy, pour her a glass.

Randy pours her a glass, Big Ben gives Katrina to drink.

The DOCTOR (54) comes in.

Big Ben stands up and shakes his hand.

DOCTOR Lung inflammation, fever 104...

BIG BEN

What?

DOCTOR Pneumonia, plus the diarrhoea and the...

BIG BEN Is she gonna be alright?

A NURSE (19) walks in and leaves the food.

DOCTOR We'll do everything in our power.

The doctor and the nurse leave, Big Ben sits down and begins to feed Katrina.

BIG BEN Ran, can you give us a moment?

Randy nods and leaves.

INT. CORRIDOR - NIGHT

Randy walks away.

BIG BEN (OS) Kay, remember the time your high heels broke and I had to... INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy sits alone in the car.

RANDY (VO) I had never seen Big, like that, and Trina so, quiet. Weird.

Randy sees Big Ben walk towards the car, he gets in. Big Ben starts the car and leaves.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

Randy and Big Ben walk into the garage.

From the corner rushes out a car and MEN start firing.

Randy and Big Ben scamper into the garage.

INT. GARAGE - NIGHT

Randy and Big Ben stand with their backs to the walls.

BIG BEN What was that all about?

INT. GARAGE - DAY

Big Ben slumps into his seat.

BIG BEN Vincent's missing.

Big Ben looks around at Randy, Jack, Jim.

BIG BEN (CONT'D)

Well?

The men shrug and avert their eyes.

Big Ben looks at all of them one by one.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) I got enough on my plate, without Squeaky clean wanting me for breakfast!

Big Ben slams the desk.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) Ran, do you know anything about this?

Randy shakes his head.

Big Ben points at him.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) Don't lie to me.

Randy raises his hands, shaking and shrugging.

Big Ben gets up and goes around the desk.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) We going for a ride.

INT. JAIL - DAY

Squeaky Clean sits on the table, opposite him sit Big Ben and Randy.

Big Ben passes a plastic bag to Clean under the table.

Clean puts it in his pants, he nods.

BIG BEN Clean, we appreciate you seeing us.

SQUEAKY CLEAN (with a high pitched voice) I didn't appreciate my brother getting killed.

BIG BEN We had nothing to do with that.

Randy looks at Clean's clean clothes and shiny shoes.

BIG BEN (CONT'D) We had our problems but murder, no.

Big Ben shakes his head.

SQUEAKY CLEAN I'll have a problem if I find out it was you, then you'll have a problem.

Squeaky clean stands up.

CONTINUED:

SQUEAKY CLEAN (CONT'D) And I appreciate your gift. Clean nods and leaves. Big Ben breathes out heavily. BIG BEN Ran, let's go. Randy and Big Ben stand up. EXT. STREET - NIGHT The club the Cesspool, PEOPLE go into the club. INT. CLUB - NIGHT Randy and Big Ben sit down. The club is full of PEOPLE. The BARTENDER (24) hands them some beers. BIG BEN I'll have a glass of water. Randy downs a drink. RANDY Since when? What's wrong? Big Ben sips on some water. Randy drinks his water with his pinky finger erect. RANDY (CONT'D) This gentleman will have a glass of water. Randy laughs. BIG BEN I'm just relieved, Squeaky Clean is not on our behinds. RANDY I'm just glad, Quincy ain't on ours, if you know what I mean.

Randy lounges in his seat then sits back up. He looks into the distance and sees Tracy. 71.

Tracy is drinking beer after beer whilst surrounded by members of Quincy's CREW. She points to him.

TRACY He did it, he killed Vincent!

The men with her turn and look, they begin to approach.

BIG BEN (turning) I knew it...

Big Ben looks around and Randy is gone.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy in his car racing through the streets.

RANDY (VO) I was in over my head, and I knew if I didn't leave the mother city, I'd lose that head.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy is about to turn at a corner, he sees cars waiting.

RANDY (VO) By the time I got to my apartment, Big Ben was already waiting with the crew.

Randy turns the other way and leaves.

INT. FLAT - DAY

An empty room, a bed in the corner. Randy paces up and down. He goes to the window and looks out.

Mean looking MEN drive by looking around.

Randy takes out his cellphone.

RANDY Bill. Bill, it's Randy. I need you to come to this address. INT. FLAT - DAY

Bill sits on the bed drinking liquor.

BILL Oh, I heard alright, you're a dead man.

Randy paces up and down. He stops in front of Bill.

RANDY Which is why I need you to do me this favour.

Bill drinks his liquor, he burps.

BILL You can trust me.

Randy shakes his head hopelessly.

RANDY It's buried just next to the cable box. Bring me the money ASAP.

BILL What did you call me? You call me a sap?

Randy raises Bill and pushes him out.

RANDY Just bring me the money and say nothing to Penny.

Bill is bundled out.

INT. HIDE OUT - DAY

Randy sleeps in a crouched position under the blankets.

Randy inside the blankets looks up and sees the light, sound of a baby crying. Randy moves towards the light.

INT. BATHROOM, HIDE OUT - DAY

Randy sits on a toilet reading a childrens' book.

Randy lies in a bathtub.

Randy looks up from underneath the water.

INT. ROOM - DAY A pile of beans falls into a plate. He sits in the corner and eats the beans. Randy looks at his watch, time flies. Montage. Randy sits. Randy walks up and down. Randy looks out of the window and sees the sun setting. INT. ROOM - DAY Randy opens the cardboard and sees nothing, his stomach rumbles. Randy dials on his cellphone. Cellphone reads CALL UNRESPONSIVE. RANDY (VO) I was cornered. Randy sits in the corner. RANDY (VO) Literally. So I went to face the music. Music sounds outside, Randy gets up and gets out. EXT. BACK GROUND - DAY Randy uncovers a slab. He sees nothing under the slab. RANDY (VO) Bill might as well have buried me under the slab. Randy's phone RINGS, he answers. RANDY I'll be there. A tear falls down his face.

INT. MORTUARY - DAY

Body bags are opened.

Randy breaks down and cries.

Three body bags open with Penny, Bill and Tod.

OFFICER They were at the shebeen when a car drove by a sprayed the car.

The female OFFICER (32) closes the bags.

RANDY Did you find anything in the car?

OFFICER No. But the car was spray painted NOW IT'S YOUR TURN TO SEEK!

EXT. PENNY'S FLAT - DAY

Randy's car swerves and parks.

He rushes in and after sometime comes out with bags.

JOHN (VO) What did you go and get inside Penny's house?

RANDY (VO) You'll find out.

EXT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - EVENING

Randy's car swerves over the pavement.

RANDY (VO) I knew Big Ben would be angry, but not enough to kill me.

Randy goes up the doorstep, he knocks and waits.

After knocking several times, Randy tries to unlock and finds it open. He goes inside.

INT. BIG BEN'S FLAT - EVENING

Randy walks through the flat, silence.

INT. BEDROOM, BIG BEN'S FLAT - EVENING

Randy walks in.

RANDY

Big Ben?

Randy sees a pair of legs dangling. Randy closes his eyes.

RANDY (VO) I knew Big Ben was down, but not down enough to kill himself.

Randy goes into the room.

RANDY (VO) It had been on the back of my mind but I never brought it up.

Randy goes through the draws. He sees a paper written APPLICATION FOR AVRs DENIED.

RANDY (VO) Then my suspicions were confirmed. Four letters signed his death certificate.

Randy stands up and cuts off Big Ben, he carries and puts him on the bed and covers it.

RANDY (VO) But if I didn't handle my biz, I would join him under the blankets.

Randy hits the mattress in anger.

INT. GARAGE - NIGHT

Randy opens a door and sees guns.

He begins taking guns and grenades.

INT. OFFICE - NIGHT

Lipstick being applied in the mirror.

RANDY (VO) I normally put silk stockings on my head, now I put them on my legs.

Randy puts some stockings on his legs.

He steps into some high heels.

RANDY (VO) Never thought I would walk in my mother's shoes, ever.

JOHN (VO) Where is this story going, Tootsie?

EXT. STREET - NIGHT

A house party is being thrown, the street is filled with people.

INT. CAR - NIGHT

Randy parks his car, he puts on some earrings and his tooth fillers.

Randy gets out of the car.

RANDY (VO) After taking my money, the Cubans would be celebrating.

Randy's high heels walk clumsily.

INT. QUINCY'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Randy gets into the crowded house, he begins dancing.

Some MAN (19) comes and tries to dance with him, Randy beats him with his purse.

Randy sees Quincy dancing with some GIRLS.

Randy grabs a drinks and walks towards Quincy.

Randy muscles in and pushes away the girl dancing with him.

Randy begins dancing with Quincy.

(CONTINUED)

OUINCY Whoa, whoa, hold up. I never seen you... RANDY Just keep dancing, I've got a secret to tell you. Quincy tries to pull off the wig, Randy pulls it back. RANDY (CONT'D) Whoa, whoa, hold up. Let's go upstairs. QUINCY You're kind of cute but... RANDY It's about Randy. Randy takes Quincy by the hand and they go upstairs. INT. BED ROOM - NIGHT Quincy lies on the bed, he pats it. Randy walks around.

> RANDY Nice work today at the shebeen.

QUINCY He smoked my brother.

Quincy smokes a cigarette.

QUINCY (CONT'D) Now it's my turn to smoke him. Come sit and talk.

Randy sits at the edge of the bed.

RANDY Heard you found quite a bit of dough.

QUINCY I ain't telling. Well alright, I got more, way more than I bargained for.

Quincy stands up and goes to the closet, he opens it, kneels and takes off the base, inside is a bag of cash.

78.

(CONTINUED)

Quincy turns and smiles. QUINCY (CONT'D) Now he really has got to look for me. So where is he? Quincy stands. RANDY He's here, looking at you not for you. Randy takes out a big gun. RANDY (CONT'D) Say hello to my big gun. Randy shoots Quincy who falls into the closet. Randy goes to the closet and takes the money. Randy closes the closet doors. RANDY (VO) Put him in the closet he lived all his life. The door opens and a MAN grimaces and takes out his gun. Randy runs and jumps through the window. EXT. FRONT YARD - NIGHT Randy lands on the ground. WOMEN scream. Randy runs in high heels and pushes off a MAN (19) getting off his motorbike and gets on it and goes off. MEN come out and start firing. Randy raises the motorbike and escapes. EXT. HIGH WAY - DAY Randy on his motorbike.

> RANDY (VO) And I never looked back, I would probably turn into a pillar of salt, all the bitterness.

Randy passes a sign that reads: WELCOME DURBAN.

EXT. LORRAINE'S HOUSE - DAY

Randy at the doorstep, Lorraine opening the door.

Randy walks in and Lorraine closes the door.

INT. LORRAINE'S HOUSE - DAY

Randy and Lorraine sit at a table.

LORRAINE You might want to invest this.

Lorraine pats the bag.

RANDY I handed in my resignation letter.

LORRAINE Good, good.

A small dog comes up and Lorraine picks it up.

RANDY So Tracy never came around.

LORRAINE Oh she did.

Lorraine slides a newspaper.

Randy takes the newspaper.

RANDY (reading out loud) Daughter of slain businessman found dead in the gutter apparently from a drug overdose.

Randy throws down the newspaper.

LORRAINE I blame myself.

RANDY I'm just to blame.

Randy goes down on his knees.

RANDY (CONT'D) I have a confession to make.

Randy waits for a moment.

RANDY (CONT'D) I once stole money from your purse.

Lorraine laughs.

LORRAINE Well, I'm sure you can repay me back a hundred times over.

Randy takes his seat.

RANDY Well, if you forgive me I guess God can too.

RANDY (VO) I couldn't tell her, I just couldn't.

JOHN (VO)

Woos.

INT. BEDROOM - DAY

Randy covers his tattooed arms with sleeves.

He puts fillings in his teeth.

Randy puts his feet in shiny shoes.

He looks at himself in the mirror.

Lorraine comes in and pats him.

LORRAINE You and my husband are an exact fit.

EXT. CHURCH - DAY

A church.

INT. CHURCH - DAY

PEOPLE walk into a church. Randy puts his hand in some holy water.

RANDY (to Lorraine) You're right, the water didn't boil. Randy stands in front of the church with a PRIEST (41) and Lorraine.

THE PRIEST Randy do you believe in God?

RANDY

Yes.

The car Vincent was buried in at the junkyard.

THE PRIEST Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

RANDY

Yes.

Squeaky Clean behind in bars crying.

THE PRIEST Do you believe in the Holy spirit?

RANDY

Yes.

Jack and Jim are arrested.

THE PRIEST Do you renounce the devil?

RANDY

Yes.

Big Ben hangs from the ceiling.

THE PRIEST Do you renounce all works of evil.

RANDY

Yes.

Quincy lies in the closet.

THE PRIEST Are you ready to help Randy in your duty as a Compassionate parent?

LORRAINE

I am.

Penny's burial site.

THE PRIEST Receive the light of Compassion.

The priest hands Lorraine a candle.

The priest pours water on Randy.

THE PRIEST Randy, I baptise you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

INT. JOHN'S HOUSE - DAY - REAL TIME

Randy sits back.

RANDY And here I am.

John begins to clap his hands, nodding.

JOHN Fantastic. One thing though.

RANDY What's that?

John reaches into his draw, he takes out a gun.

JOHN I've got a message from Squeaky Clean, he says hello.

Randy covers his face.

John pulls the trigger.

JOHN (CONT'D) Bada bing!

John sprays Randy with water.

JOHN (CONT'D) Gotcha! It's just water.

John pats Randy.

JOHN (CONT'D) Hope you didn't wet yourself.

Randy sighs.

JOHN (CONT'D)

Listen.

John goes over the table and sits on the desk.

JOHN (CONT'D) I have my own little gambling rackets that the police don't know about, well the good ones.

RANDY

So...

JOHN If you want, you can, if you want that is, to be my debt collector.

Randy shakes his head.

RANDY Just when I thought I was out, you want to pull me back in?

John stands up and goes back to his chair.

JOHN Suit yourself. How much you got?

Randy takes out a suitcase and gives it John, who opens it.

John whistles.

JOHN (CONT'D) From what you told me, I see you're familiar with the car business. But I've been thinking of setting up my own gym.

John takes out the rands.

JOHN (CONT'D) I can give you a little bit more and you can have a bigger share.

RANDY I like the sound of that.

John closes the suitcase.

JOHN Everybody deserves a second chance.

Randy and John shake hands.

Montage. A building is quickly reconstructed and made into a gym.

EXT. STREET - DAY

Lorraine, John and Randy stand as FIDDLES is put onto the top of the building.

Randy puts a hand around Lorraine.

A slim Dolly comes with some papers.

DOLLY Now, sir just sign here.

Randy takes the paper and signs, he smiles at Dolly and she smiles at him.

EXT. CITY STREET - DAY

Words typed out 13 years later.

Fiddles gymnasium.

INT. GYMNASIUM - DAY

Sound of heavy breathing.

A fat MAN (21) on a treadmill.

An old MAN (77) on the next treadmill.

A beautiful GIRL (19) surrounded by five MEN on the next treadmill.

BENJAMIN biracial (10) on the next treadmill.

RANDY biracial (40) in a red tank top on the next treadmill.

View on Randy.

He stops the machine and gets off.

RANDY Benny, that's it.

Benjamin keeps jogging on the treadmill.

RANDY (CONT'D) Ay Benny, let's go son.

Benny keeps jogging. Randy takes off Benny's ipod.

RANDY (CONT'D) That's enough for today, it's 6pm tomorrow's a school day.

Benny gets off the machine.

BENNY

Oh, alright.

Randy walks with Benny, his arm around his shoulder.

Randy stops by the fat man. He pats him on the back.

RANDY

Keep it up.

The fat man nods.

RANDY (CONT'D) Hope your fiance got the flowers that I sent to her.

INT. RECEPTION, GYMNASIUM - DAY

Randy and Benny stop at the reception. The RECEPTIONIST (23) lady smiles at Randy.

RECEPTIONIST You're leaving, why so early, Randy?

RANDY Meeting, you can close a little bit later.

The receptionist looks him over his muscular tattooed body.

Randy snaps his fingers.

Rand and Benny leave.

INT. INTER CUTTING TV ROOM, RANDY'S HOUSE/ CAR - DAY

Randy in his red car, Benny is on a video game beside him.

A Bible is on the dashboard, a picture of Jesus hangs from the rear view mirror.

Randy's arm is tattooed 666.

Randy dials his phone.

RANDY Hey sweety, I'm a be home early. I'll just drop the kids at Grand's.

DOLLY, a fat white woman (37) eats cookies from a packet whilst sitting on a couch.

RANDY (CONT'D) Are you watching..?

DOLLY Yes, the soaps wash away my boredom.

Dolly eats hungrily. A soap opera unfolds on the television screen.

SOAP CHARACTER (OS) I hunger for your love.

RANDY I'm about to pick up Frank.

DOLLY (with food in her mouth) Good, good.

SOAP CHARACTER (OS) I am consumed with passion.

INT. CAR - DAY

BENNY Mom, seriously needs to come to the gym.

Randy laughs.

RANDY Don't want to lie to you buddy, the only gym your mother will ever know is Jim Carey. The car arrives at a sport's field.

ATHLETES are running, doing high jump and throwing javelins and discs.

FRANKLIN (12) comes over to the car, he waves to some GIRLS and gets in.

RANDY Driving the girls crazy son?

FRANK Just drive, OK.

Randy hesitates to start the car.

RANDY You not embarrassed of your dad, are you?

 $$\ensuremath{\mathsf{FRANK}}$$ I'm just tired and exhausted OK, can we go.

Randy starts the car, the exhaust pipe churns out smoke and the tires begin to move.

Frank and Benny make some creative handshake.

EXT. GRANDMOTHER'S HOUSE - EVENING

Randy and his two sons are standing next to LORRAINE a white woman (81).

RANDY Now don't go feeding them your cookies.

LORRAINE Dolly doesn't seem to mind them.

Randy gets into the car.

RANDY OK, maybe one or two. See you guys later.

Randy waves and leaves.

Grandmother leans on her cane.

LORRAINE How are your grades?

Frank shrugs and pushes his brother.

FRANK Ask him, he's the smartie pants.

Benny shuffles his feet.

BENNY I perform adequately.

LORRAINE

Excellent.

Grandmother looks them over.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) You boys need fattening up. Your father treating you like oxen.

She giggles.

LORRAINE (CONT'D) I'll treat you like Hansel and Graettle.

FRANK

I'm starving.

She walks slowly on her cane as the two run inside.

GRANDMOTHER You're lucky my husband isn't here, God rest his soul, he wouldn't want those dirty shoes on his carpet.

INT. KITCHEN, RANDY'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Randy sits on the table.

RANDY At last we can have some alone time.

Dolly nods and puts on her gloves.

DOLLY Well I hope you're hungry? RANDY We just ate.

Dolly goes to the oven.

DOLLY

I used to be such a doll. You spoilt me with your cooking, now it's my turn.

Dolly opens the oven door with buns inside.
