**INT. TALKING HEADS - DAY**

We see a man in his early twenties with slicked back hair and a suit.

**SUPERIMPOSE: JEREMY ISSACS - IVY LEAGUE GRADUATE**

JEREMY

So you get all these people and they come up with solar panels and wind farms and food energy. None of them work. I even know this guy right, who wanted to harvest energy from exercise bikes on that show... The Biggest Loser. It's complete rubbish. All of it. But we have come up with the answer. The perpetual motion machine.

REPORTER (O.S.)

I'm sorry?

JEREMY

It's a machine that produces an infinite amount of energy without any external...

(CONTINUED)

REPORTER (O.S.)  
Yes, I know what it is but... Don't they say that'd impossible?

JEREMY  
No.

REPORTER (O.S.)  
I think they do say that.

JEREMY  
No they don't. That's just speculation.

REPORTER (O.S.)  
(skeptical)  
Right.

Now we see another man in his twenties, this one even slicker than the last.

**SUPERIMPOSE: M. TUCKER - SPIN DOCTOR**

TUCKER  
Well, what happens is the mechanistic dissimulator sends a series of sinesis waves through the schism paraplex and the myshicalisobolic kaschphinctalator spins at an andromacular rate which means that the thinylatist produces the most green, clean and paramalistic energy in the world.

REPORTER (O.S.)  
I'm sorry, a lot of that went over my head.

TUCKER

REPORTER (O.S.)

TUCKER

REPORTER (O.S.)

BOB

REPORTER (O.S.)  
But the perpetual motion machine could be the solution to the energy crisis.

BOB  
I think that we should consider "alternatives" before we jump on the pseudo-science bandwagon.

We **FREEZE FRAME** on Bob.

REPORTER (V.O.)  
Mr. Bob Burns has since been implicated in a scandal involving a stripper, weed and a dildo. He has declined to further comment.

**EXT. STREET - DAY**

A cameraman follows Bob as he tries to escape to his car. As he gets into his car he stressfully turns to the camera.

BOB

Get the fuck away from me you media hounds!

**INT. TALKING HEADS - DAY**
