CLOSE UP: RACHAEL EATING HER PIZZA.

CLOSE UP: GEORGE EATING HIS PIZZA.

RACHAEL
This baby won't ruin anything.

GEORGE
You're only 7 weeks in goddammit!

George slams his fists down against the table. Camera cuts into Rachael's POV. George stares directly into the camera.

This guy I know owns an abortion place. We can go there right now and it will be like you weren't even pregnant.

RACHAEL
Rachael is shaking and drops of tears are hitting the table.

I will not do that to my baby. That is the last time I want to hear about that. I will not just give up my baby like that. You're making me sick that you would even consider going to that place.

CLOSE UP: RACHAEL CHOMPS AT HER PIZZA.

GEORGE
I am too young to have a baby ruin my life. I don't want a baby. Why

don't you just do us both a favor
and go to that...place.

CLOSE UP: GEORGE CHOMPS AT HIS PIZZA.

RACHAEL

I don't need you. I would be
perfectly fine without you. I'm
having this baby whether you're here
or not. Now get out of my parent's
house before I call them and tell
them what you're trying to get me to
do!

GEORGE

George starts to laugh hysterically. He dangles his pizza
and points it at Rachael.

You're really dumb you know that?
You need me more than I need you.
Tell your parents what I said, I
don't give a damn. And we're done.
Don't call me back later tonight and
try to sweet talk me back. I'm done
for good.

George walks to the door, still laughing. He opens the door
then turns around.

You're gonna regret this decision.
Years later you're gonna wish you
never even thought about leaving me.

George turns around and slams the door.

FADE OUT.

BIG WHITE ON BLACK LETTERS READ, "25 YEARS LATER."

BABY BLUE BY BADFINGER PLAYS OVER SHOTS.

INT. SMALL APARTMENT ROOM - NIGHT

FADE IN.

George is sitting on a couch, eating a TV dinner, and
drinking a Beer. He has gained 40 pounds. He picks up the
beer and accidentally spills it all over himself. He looks
up and screams.

GEORGE

FUCK!!!!!!!!!!!!

FREEZE FRAME: GEORGE SCREAMING WITH HANDS RAISED INTO THE AIR.

RACHAEL (V.O)
George, George went on to be nothing. He had a small apartment and worked a construction job that paid a little over minimum wage. He hated his life and he deserved to.

CUT TO RACHAEL'S SON, ANDREW BEING SIGNED TO THE YANKEES. THE PLAYER SHAKES THE HAND OF THE OWNER. THEY BOTH HOLD UP THE PLAYER'S JERSEY. FREEZE FRAME OF THEM HOLDING UP THE JERSEY.

RACHAEL (V.O)
Now my son, Andrew, was the number one college recruit in the United States for baseball. He was drafted by the Yankees first overall in the 2038 MLB Draft. He is now being paid close to 100 million dollars a year.

CUT TO RACHAEL AND ANDREW SITTING AND EATING AT A DINNER TABLE. THIS DINNER TABLE NOW HAS A BEAUTIFUL CLOTH ON IT. THEY ARE EATING STEAK OFF OF FANCY CHINA. CANDLES ARE LIT AS A CENTER PIECE.

Rachael and Andrew are eating the steak. They both look up and smile.

FREEZE FRAME: ANDREW AND RACHAEL ARE SMILING AT EACH OTHER.

RACHAEL (V.O)
I quit my job as a waitress after Andrew signed his contract. I now live in a beautiful home in Hoboken, New Jersey with Andrew. I go to every Yankees home game now.

Rachael and Andrew and standing outside Yankee stadium, smiling and fixing each other's clothes for a picture. They turn to the camera and smile.

FREEZE FRAME: ANDREW AND RACHAEL ARE SMILING AT THE CAMERA WITH YANKEE STADIUM BEHIND THEM.

RACHAEL (V.O)

FADE OUT.
