

## Camp Olympic Story Circle Ep. 1

1. Comfort Zone- Chris lives at home with his dad, blissfully unaware of what is to come
2. Need or Desire- Get at least one kid to like and respect him
3. Unfamiliar Situation- Chris gets a group and a partner, chaos ensues since all the kids fucking hate him
4. Adaptation- Chris begins to settle into his position with help from his superior, trying to win them over by playing baseball
5. Get what they wanted- After securing an amazing hit in the game, he showboats and Henry begins to take a liking to him
6. But pay a price- He makes one of the kids cry, getting his ass beat and gaining an enemy
7. Return to comfort- Chris ends the day at the camp's office with his dad
8. Having Changed- He gets hugged by Henry, gets the 100 dollars

Inciting incident: Chris is assigned a group

### Act 1

Chris is a lazy high schooler who just wants to enjoy his summer. His father, Jed, wants him to not waste his time doing nothing and extends an invitation for Chris to work at the summer camp he runs. Chris is hesitant, but decides to give it a shot so he can bomb it and tell his dad he's not up for it. They arrive, clean up, and get to work. Chris meets some of the campers, the rest of the counselors, and is assigned a group. Go time.

### Act 2

Chris struggles in his position and the kids do not respect him. Fun and games, Chris patience with the kids begins to wear thin. Various sports occur in rapid succession, testing Chris' mettle and showing him this is not gonna be an easy month. During lunch, the new hires share their experiences with the veterans. A kid beats another, of course it's one of Chris'. Towards the end of the lunch period, Chris learns that the day's final activity is playing baseball.

### Act 3

Cut to a few hours, at the field. Chris and Jed are in opposing teams, and the game heats up as Chris gets his ass handed to him. After an embarrassing few innings, Chris decides that enough is enough and starts taking the game super seriously. He lands an incredible hit and showboats, causing one of the kids to cry. - Chris- Main dude, make him more interesting and not a whiny cunt. Maybe more shy, breaking out of his shell more and more as the story progresses.

- Nala- Nana. In charge, no nonsense person. Jed's right hand. She may seem incredibly intimidating at first, but she's very soft on the inside.
- María- Maritere ish. I'll think about it.
- Lainey- Comes in at the end of ep 1, Chris' dream girl. She's so lovely it's incredible. Loves a good prank.
- David- Cool dude, everyone respects the fuck out of him and lays into one of the parents that

- disrespects one of the kids. Somewhat threatening, has a heart of gold.
- Archie- Him and Chris become very close friends. Funny, loyal, charismatic, and somewhat wild. His younger brother is a camper who enjoys dicking around with him.

## **CAMPERS**

- Jonah- Archie's brother. Absolute troublemaker with a golden heart. Wants to separate from his brother's image and be his own person. Jonell.
- Henry- Ricardo. Incredibly bright kid, on the spectrum. He's very misunderstood and always has good intentions, but is judged for his condition.
- Pamela- Young girl with tourettes. Extremely shy, mother brought her to camp to break her out of her shell. Kids don't understand and are afraid of her/ tease her. Chris is especially protective of her.
- Joshua- self explanatory. Huge prick. Chris' enemy.
- Roxy- Diva. Hooo boy.

## **ACT 1**

### **INT. JED'S HOUSE- NIGHT/ EARLY MORNING**

- Commercial plays on TV
- Chris isn't convinced by the commercial's quality, declines Jed's initial offer to work
- Jed tries to convince Chris to work, swindles Chris with 100 dollars
- Chris accepts the offer
- Jed sends him to bed
- A few hours go by and Jed awakens Chris with a pot and a spoon, handing him a bag
- Chris meets Jed at the car in his new uniform, they drive off

### **EXT. COMMUNITY CENTER- EARLY MORNING**

- Jed and Chris arrive and have a short conversation

### **INT. COMMUNITY CENTER- EARLY MORNING / MORNING**

- Chris and Jed walk in and take in the sights
- Jed takes a deep breath and the smell chokes him out
- After regaining his composure they clean up
- Jed exits after hearing a car arrive

### **EXT. COMMUNITY CENTER- MORNING**

- Nala and Maria show up
- Jed welcomes them and they embrace, introduces them to Chris
- They tease him for a bit, getting him a little antsy
- In the midst of this, David shows up, and greets everyone

- Then comes in Lainey, who immediately catches Chris' attention
- Last arrival is Archie, who's charisma wins everyone over really fast
- Jed assigns everyone their partners. Nala has 3-5, Maria and Lainey have 6-8, Chris and Jed have 9-11, Archie and David have 12-15
- Jed gives a motivational speech to try and calm Chris
- Shot of Chris' face, smash cut to

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER- MORNING

- It's total fucking mayhem, kids are misbehaving and not listening to Chris
- Chris passes a crying Jacob
- He goes to pull off a kid from beating another
- Passes by Jacob again, Jacob is soaked in sweat
- Archie is playing with some of the kids, they instantly like him
- He leads a conga line
- Nala, Maria, and the little ones sing songs, play pitufo
- David calmly tells the older kids about one of his scars as they listen in amazement, all of this accomplished with a long shot
- Jed takes in the view, blows on his whistle
- Gives commencement speech, no phones, safety, etc, they split off to start the day

#### ACT 2

#### EXT. BASKETBALL COURT- DAY

- First sport of the day is basketball
- The kids pick their teams as Jed and Chris watch from the sidelines
- Jed excitedly mentions that he's very happy to work side by side with his son
- Chris mentions he's still super nervous
- Jed reassures him that everything will be okay
- A kid comes up to Jed and tells him they're done picking teams
- Jed tells Chris to stand up and come with him
- They arrive where the kids are, they both get picked, the game starts
- Jed tells the kids that whichever counselor they picked will be their team leader for the day
- Chris' team has the slower and less athletic kids, so they're getting their asses kicked, with Joshua teasing Chris' kids nonstop.
- They throw the ball in the wrong baskets, etc
- Game is over, we move to the next sport, volleyball

#### EXT. VOLLEYBALL COURT- DAY

- Just like in basketball, Chris' kids are hopeless
- Jed encourages his team, they love him
- Chris tries teaching them how to hit the ball to no avail, the kids don't listen to him
- Ball gets thrown into a tree
- The other counselors pop in and out to see how Chris is doing
- They lose again

- Next up, ping-pong

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER- DAY

- Chris tells the kids to not break the ping pong balls or paddles
- Before he finishes saying that, the kids throw a paddle at his head and it breaks
- Massive sigh

#### EXT. POOL- DAY

- Chris and Jed stay vigilant with the kids, making sure they don't rough house each other
- At one of the ends of the pool, Joshua is putting Henry's head underwater
- Chris dashes towards them and gets Joshua off Henry, asking Henry if he's okay
- In his shyness, Henry swims away without saying a word
- He reprimands him, and Joshua acts like a little shit, telling Chris to go fuck himself
- Chris has just about had it and is about to go off on him when Jed comes up and tells Joshua off, who acts innocently
- Jed walks away as Joshua "apologizes" to Chris, flips him off when Jed's back is turned
- Chris screams into his hands

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER- DAY

- The kids all sit at the tables, the counselors sit at another keeping them in check
- They ask the new hires how their day has been
- Lainey and Archie have had a wonderful day, Chris obviously has not
- Jed tells him it'll build character, and that it's not so bad
- As he finishes that, Joshua throws an apple at Chris and calls him a dick
- Being such an asshole takes so much energy, Jesus
- Lainey asks what's next
- Jed explains that all groups will now go to the field to play various sports. (Duck Duck Goose, Soccer, Football, Baseball)
- Lunch time is over, time to head over to the field

- Henry pitches for Chris' team, and understandably, he's not very good, but Chris encourages him.
- They start getting a little better with Chris' encouragement, but they fall back into old habits.
- They're getting slammed, and Joshua steps up to the home plate.

- Hits a great hit, Chris is amazed, but it's cut short when he reaches the home plate and insults Henry so bad he begins to cry. Chris has had enough. He begins to comfort Henry, inappropriately telling him he's gonna push Joshua's shit in. Henry, as always, is quiet.
- Chris starts taking the game super seriously. Dude legit believes he's in the MLB.
- The teams are tied, and Chris steps up to the plate. Joshua teases him saying that if his swing is as bad as his leadership the team is doomed
- Chris fucking slams it. Home run, they win!
- He turns to the kids and they're so shocked they're mute. Henry starts screaming in support.
- He starts running, showboating and hyping his kids up

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER OFFICE

- Jed tells him that he never interrupted because he wanted to test Chris' mettle
- Chris is not amused, he thinks the kids still hate him, and now he's super injured

#### EXT. COMMUNITY CENTER ENTRANCE

- The other counselors hand the kids to their parents, the kids are super pleased
- Kids say goodbye to Archie, he makes them laugh
- Lainey is just lovely n shit
- Goddamn she's great

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER OFFICE

- Chris mopes a bit, since he wasn't even able to get a kid to like him
- Jed teases him, saying he's gonna be a tv star in a year's time

#### EXT. COMMUNITY CENTER ENTRANCE

- Henry sits on a bench by his lonesome, and his parents arrive.
- Henry hugs them, but tells them to wait as he runs inside

#### INT. COMMUNITY CENTER

- Henry scans for the office door

#### EXT. COMMUNITY CENTER OFFICE

- Chris looks like roadkill
- Henry knocks on the door
- Jed greets him, Henry says he has to leave
- Chris sits up
- Jed asks him if he had a good time, Henry agrees, saying he felt understood
- He stretches out a high five for Jed, he complies

- Henry looks at Chris, and high fives him
- Chris looks like he's seen a ghost
- Henry walks away
- Chris stares at his hand, then stares at his dad
- He smiles from ear to ear
- Jed complies and gives him the hundred
