EXT. RIVER - MORNING

JACK TURNER (55) Hides in the bushes with a rifle pointed at the deer. He's skinny with messy hair and a beard.

He FIRES the gun as the deer falters to the ground.

LATER

THE BUSHES

An animal carcass lays on the ground. He kneels down to examine it closer.

EXT. CABIN - DAY

EXT. CABIN - NIGHT

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

Jack is having a nightmare as a storm brews outside.

Lightening flashes across his body with each turn he makes.

THE NIGHTMARE

Jack lays on a metal table in a strange, dark room. He tries to speak but nothing comes out.

He turns his head to see multiple people in the room with him, who're standing with their eyes open but completely motionless.

END DREAM

Jack wakes up screaming and crawling out bed and into a corner.

JACK

INT. CABIN - NIGHT

JACK

JACK

I'm sorry. I haven't drank -

LILLY

(interrupts)

I'm getting married... And I was wondering if my daddy could be there?

JACK

Of course Lil. Of course I will.

They hug.

From the porch, Danny watches them, confused.

Jack and Lilly separate from the hug.

JACK

(to Lilly)

I may have to have a shave first, huh?

They laugh as she wipes away tears.

EXT. CABIN PORCH - MORNING

It's a beautiful morning as Jack stands out on the porch, with renewed hope, drinking coffee.

He's staring at Danny sleeping on the couch as Lilly joins him with coffee of her own.

LILLY

Good morning.

JACK

Hey, kiddo.

JACK

Say, what if I took him fishing? I'll bet he's never been.

LILLY

Better be quick. We need to get back.

JACK

So.. what's the guys name?

LILLY

Jason. Been together for years, finally decided to do it.

JACK

Year's huh? Why'd it take you so long?

Lilly looks at him incredulously.

JACK

Sorry.

LILLY

I'll wake him.

EXT. SMALL CREEK - MORNING

Jack teaches Danny how to fish.

JACK

JACK

(in disbelief)
