It's been a long road, but you did it. I know it's bad to talk ill of the dead, but personally, I think it was God's will someone hit your husband. Hell, if I knew who it was, I'd kiss him or her right on the lips. Anyway, have a good day, love. Let's grab lunch some time. Okay, I gotta go. Bye. Mwah!

Tani shakes her head chuckling. She tosses the phone on the bed and heads into the RESTROOM.

INT. TANI'S HOME - BEDROOM - LATER

Tani is fully dressed in her officer uniform. She tugs on her collar.

TANI

Hello, I am Officer Green and I am here to Serve and Protect.

She takes a deep breath, gives her reflection a smile and nod then leaves.

EXT. DRIVEWAY - DAY

Tani goes to her car in all smiles.

She looks over at her closed garage door. Her smiles fades, her face expressionless.

She shakes it off and climbs into her car.

INT. PRECINCT LOCKER ROOM - DAY

Tani and her partner OFFICER CHANCE FLOORING, 40s, Caucasian, bald, CLING their soda cans together.

CHANCE

Cheers to your return!

TANI

CHANCE

I'm surprised you wanted to come back. You sure you want to come back to criminals and corruption?

Tani laughs.

TANI

It's fine. It'll be a great distraction.

Chance raise his can again before he takes a drag.

CHANCE

Well, welcome back partner.

Chance sets aside his soda and hands Tani her gun and badge.

TANI

INT. INTERROGATION ROOM - DAY

TANI

TANI (CONT'D)

ALLISON

TANI

You were arrested for attempted murder and assault toward your husband, Joshua Brooker. You want to tell me what happened?

ALLISON

Why? What difference will it make? Why not just lock me up?

TANI

That's coming soon enough. For right now, I want to know what happened.

Allison chuckles.

ALLISON

I spent all day cleaning. I cooked dinner. He came home mad about God knows what and decided to try and take it out on me. I grabbed a bat and the rest is history.

TANI

Has he attacked you before?

ALLISON

I know you've read my file, what do you think?

TANI

A VOICE comes behind her.

VOICE

Hello.

Tani spins around. It is a MALE NURSE, late 20s, blonde highlights. He scribbles on his notepad.

MALE NURSE

Hello, I am Nurse Thompson. What can I do for you, Officer?

TANI

I wanted to check up on Mr. Broker, for his wife.

The nurse looks over at Joshua and shakes his head.

NURSE THOMPSON

It's a shame isn't it? Nearly killed the guy and she wants to know how he's doing.

TANI

For good reason. He beat on her.

NURSE THOMPSON

Did she ever report it?

TANI

Of course, but never went through with the charges.

Nurse Thompson chuckles.

NURSE THOMPSON

Figures.

Tani's jaw tighten.

TANI

What is his status?

NURSE THOMPSON

TANI

Her jaw tightens.

She studies photos of Allison and Joshua together. One photo shows Allison far along in pregnancy.

TANI

Pregnant?

INT. HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

She is stunned to silence as she gaze over more images of Allison and Joshua. This time, Allison's face is clearly bruised but she poses as if nothing is wrong.

TANI

Allison...

INT. BEDROOM - CONTINUOUS

She comes across two crochet bunnies. Each with a name sewn into the tummy. One reads CONNOR, the other KENNA.

TANI
