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COLD OPENING / A

FADE IN:

Chris is 40-years old and likes helping his son. He's not afraid to poke fun at him and his group of friends.

Charlie Well we are finally here.

Matt Hopefully the key works

Charlie I'll hit you if it doesn't. Looks bigger than the pictures.

Matt That's cause there was furniture in the pictures

Charlie That's true

Matt Where's your dad, I thought he was following us?

Charlie He said he had to stop at the store and grab something

> Matt Hopefully some food, I'm starving.

Charlie He said he'd probably get a pizza for all of us once the other two get here.

Matt Oh who knows when that could be with those two, he could at least grab some snacks.

Charlie You'll be fine, so what are we thinking, couch here, tv there and beer pong table there.

Matt

Chris Jackson - Charlie's dad - walks through the door. He sets a box down on the kitchen counter.

Charlie

COLD OPENING / B

INT: LIVING ROOM -

Samantha is an 18-year old female with long blonde hair. She looks like a cheerleader but is mature for her age.

A girl knocks on the door and enters.

Samantha Hey, I'm sorry to bother you. Do you happen to have a pair of scissors I can borrower for a minute. I have one box I can't get open.

> Chris Yeah no problem, you live in the building?

Samantha Yeah I'm just next door. I'm Samantha.

Chris Chris Jackson, nice to meet you. I'm helping my son and his friends move in.

Samantha Oh cool, my dad was supposed to come help but my grandma had an accident.

> Chris Oh I'm sorry to hear that is she ok?

Samantha Oh yeah. She is just senile and went walking in her neighborhood naked so someone called the cops on her.

Chris gives Samantha a surprising look

Chris Well here are the scissors.

Samantha Thanks I'll bring them back in a minute

> Chris No problem

Samantha exits the apartment while Charlie and Matt come out from the hallway leading to their rooms.

Charlie Who was that?

Chris Your neighbor, she needed to borrower scissors.

> Matt Wait, a girl lives next door?

Chris Yes a girl lives next door.

Charlie Well what did she look like, was she hot?

> Matt Oh yeah, she's hot.

Chris How did you get she's hot from blonde hair and her height.

Samantha walks in to return the scissors.

Samantha No I should be good, my roommate will be here soon.

ACT ONE

Chris

INT: SAMANTHA'S APARTMENT – LIVING ROOM. (Samantha, Grace)

Her roommate Grace walks in for the first time.

Grace is a 17-year-old with long brown hair. She is a diva and keeps her boyfriend in check.

Samantha Hey how are you? I'm Samantha nice to finally meet you.

Grace Hey nice to meet you. Have you been here long?

Samantha Uhh just a few hours. I've got most of my room set up and I was just taking a little break.

> Grace Nice, thanks for bringing an extra tv for the living room.

Samantha Oh no problem, did you need any help bringing your stuff in?

> Grace No my boyfriend's got it.

Samantha You sure? I don't mind helping. Grace No trust me, he forgot to text me when he got home from work last night so paybacks a bitch.

> Samantha Ok then... how was your drive here?

Chris Nothing, that sounds like good idea. Did any of you talk to a counselor to figure out what classes to take? Charlie, Axle and Matt Nope

Terrance I did.

Chris Now that's a smart man.

INT. SAMANTHA'S APARTMENT.

Grace and her boyfriend Adam walk out of her room arguing while Samantha is on the couch.

Adam is a 19-year old male. Tall with short brown hair. Good looking guy but not the brightest.

Grace I told you it was a bad idea to go away to college.

Adam No it's not you're going to have a great time here.

Grace Yeah while I'm constantly wondering who you're cheating on me with.

Adam Oh my god for the thousandth time I've never cheated on you. I have pictures that are time stamped of me with my parents last weekend.

Grace Oh yeah like you couldn't have just changed the time the picture was taken on your phone.

Adam exits the room.

ACT TWO

Fade In:

FADE IN:

Int. <u>JIMMY</u> AND <u>TYLER'S</u>, WHO LIVE ACROSS THE HALL, APARTMENT LIVING ROOM – CONINTUOUS (DAY 1) (Tyler, Jimmy, Terrance)

Tyler and Jimmy are smoking weed watching TV.

Jimmy Bro where did you get this stuff?

> Tyler I know a guy.

Jimmy I know a guy too but he doesn't sell me stuff like this.

> Tyler It's called Tim Burton.

> > Jimmy I so get that.

Tyler Bro we should totally order a pizza.

Jimmy From where? I don't know where the closest pizza place is.

Tyler takes a hit of the bong.

Tyler Just ask the iPhone chick.

Jimmy Serious?

Tyler Yeah I'm serious ask her.

Jimmy No isn't that her name, serious?

Tyler grabs his phone

FADE IN:
