FADE IN:

EXT. COUNTRY - NIGHT

Moonlight strikes a parked car on the dirt road. Overgrown trees and brush are barely visible in the night's shadows.

A closer look at the automobile reveals an empty, darkcolored sedan with an open driver's side door.

BILL (30's) clean cut and wearing a business suit, crawls over dirt and gravel to follow on the high heels of, Nancy, directly in front of him, wearing a tight-fitting mini skirt.

> BILL Are you alright?

> > NANCY

Shhhh...

BILL (whispers) Sorry. I've never been shot at before.

NANCY (20's), cute in a tuff sort of way, SCREAMS out in pain. She lifts her left hand to take a look.

NANCY

Damned rocks.

Nancy and Bill cop a squat by the trunk. Nancy elevates her bloody left hand and rubs her knees with her right hand. She looks to the gravel.

A bullet only inches from her body.

AT A TREE

DANIEL (50'S). His dark silhouette almost hidden within the shadows. He fires his handgun toward the car, BAM, BAM, BAM.

BACK TO NANCY AND BILL

Bill notices the open buttons on her blouse and reaches for her breast. She swats his hand away with her injured hand.

NANCY

Ow! Stop!

BILL Let me see. Bill inspects her injury. BILL You've been hit! She jerks her hand back. NANCY If I was hit, you'd know. Am I howling in pain? No. I'm fine. She kicks at the bullet and slides it away. NANCY (yells) You're shooting at me, Daniel?! Really? BILL Daniel? What? NANCY My brother. Nancy rips a strip of cloth from the bottom of her blouse and wraps it around her wound. BILL Nancy, what's going on? NANCY You told me you'll love me forever, and you cheated. You cheated on me. A look of confusion appears on Bill's face. BILL What are you talking about? NANCY I saw you, Bill. Why? I loved you enough to protect you.

BILL Protect me. From what?

A wolf HOWLS in the distance.

NANCY

My brother.

BANG! BANG! BANG! of gunshots forces them both to duck.

NANCY (CON'T) He had a head injury and gets confused sometimes. He thinks he's still a cop and everybody is the bad guy.

She turns her head away.

NANCY He's mine, Daniel! Quit shooting! I've got him!

BILL How do you know it's him?

Her head snaps toward Bill.

NANCY I saw his car following us. The same way that I saw you making out with your secretary.

Bill looks away.

NANCY (CON'T) Plus, he always wants what I have.

BILL

Always?

NANCY Since we were pups.

BILL Tell him you told me to kick rocks. That I'm gone. (pause) Geezus, he's gay. Is he gay?

NANCY He's Daniel. And telling him that I don't have you will only push him over the edge. BILL Oh, Gawd, I've never even gotten a colonoscopy. That part of my body is virginal.

NANCY

Shut up. He's not gay, but he does like the taste of mindless little twits sprinkled with pepper.

BILL

Nancy, I'm sorry if I hurt you. I don't know why I did it.

NANCY

Where is your sense of loyalty, Bill? You would never fit into a pack. (pause) Er, I mean a family.

BILL

Awe, Nancy, why don't we kiss and make up? Give me another chance. I can do better.

Bill puckers up and leans towards Nancy. She pushes him away.

NANCY

Are you serious?

BILL

Okay, then. If it's over, it's over. I say we get back in the car and drive it like we stole it.

NANCY

With two flat front tires? We wouldn't make it to the end of the road, then we'd both be dead meat.

BILL

Both be dead meat?

Nancy stares off into the distance.

NANCY Yeah. He's shooting at us, remember? BILL I knew I should have followed you in my car. We gotta' leave.

Bill crawls toward the brush.

BILL (CON'T)

Come on.

Nancy crawls behind him. She catches up to him fast and bumps him hard enough to knock him over. He turns to her.

BILL I don't remember you having any facial hair.

NANCY You have never pissed me off before, and double whammy for you... It's a full moon.

Nancy HOWLS.

A look of terror strikes across Bill's face.

BILL Nancy? Your teeth!

SKY - CONTINUOUS

The full moon shines brightly.

BILL (O.S.) You're a werewolf?! Help! Help, somebody!

A wolf HOWLS O.S.

NANCY (O.S.) Daniel, you found us. I already told you, he's mine. Go away!

Two wolves GROWL, SCREAM, and WHIMPER as they fight O.S.

EXT. COUNTRY - NIGHT - CONTINUOUS

Bill crouches down as he rushes out of the brush.

Wolves continue to GROWL, SCREAM, and WHIMPER O.S.

A compact car moves down the road at a slow pace.

Bill runs for the car.

He opens the car door and gets inside.

INT. CAR - NIGHT - CONTINUOUS

LONNIE, long haired and 20 something, sits behind the wheel. He glares at Bill.

Bill locks his door. He nervously looks here and there out the windows.

BILL

Go! Go!

Lonnie stomps on the gas.

Bill looks at the blood coming from a wound on his forearm. Lonnie notices.

LONNIE You're bleeding.

BILL I got bit.

LONNIE You must have run into Nancy or Daniel.

Lonnie has Bill's complete attention.

BILL

Both.

LONNIE They're slipping.

Lonnie pulls the car over and puts the gear shift into park.

LONNIE You would have never gotten away back in the day, Bill.

That remark struck Bill like a sucker punch.

BILL How did you know my name?

Lonnie faces him.

LONNIE Daniel and Nancy are my brother and sister. We talk.

Lonnie grins at Bill's fright.

LONNIE It's not our fault. It's uncontrollable during a full moon.

Lonnie's smile widens.

BILL Oh, no. No.

LONNIE She loved you enough to ask if you could join us. Then we heard about you and your secretary.

Lonnie laughs.

LONNIE Are you scared?

Lonnie throws his hands up.

LONNIE

Boo!

Bill SCREAMS and claws at the door.

Nancy's face appears in Bill's window. A grin spreads across her face.

Bill SCREAMS again.

NANCY Lonnie, he's all yours. Not my taste at all.

BILL

Nancy! No!

Bill turns and slaps at Lonnie.

Nancy and Daniel walk away from the car as it begins to rock from side to side. Bill's SCREAMS fill the night.

NANCY I want to find someone who'll truly love me forever.

DANIEL

You will or they'll die trying.

NANCY True. I'm hiding your gun, you know.

Daniel hands her his weapon.

DANIEL

Here.

NANCY Thanks. I think I'll head on over to Soho. I could go for a little Chinese right about now.

Daniel nods.

DANIEL

And I saw an old lady that smelled like fried chicken and chocolate chip cookies over on Main Street.

NANCY

I'll see you at home then.

DANIEL See you at home.

The two separate and go in different directions.

SKY

The full moon and all it's glory.
