TEASER

CUT TO:

GENERAL DAVIDSON

Dave opens the door and salute General Davidson. Then,

GENERAL DAVIDSON (CONT'D)

Dave, looking seriously, clears his throat as he reply.

DAVE

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. DORM-ROOM - NIGHT

It's night, it's very quiet in the hall of dormitory, as we
getting closer to room 26, we see Dave Malkovich is packing
his stuff in the bag. As he packs, he finds a picture that it
is taken on his first day in the Marines. He looks at picture
very sadly, almost start crying, but his friend in the
Marines interrupt him and Dave clears tears and pack the
picture in a bag.

SOLDIER 2

We'll miss out here, man. You were one
of the best leaders in the U.S Marines
that we ever had ---- I mean we had
one before you, but he was nothing
compare to you, he didn't even know
how to clean a gun, can you imagine
how dumb he was.

Dave chuckles. He looks at soldier.

DAVE

Yea, I know story about him very well.
Sgt. Milton, from Alpha-3 Team, had
told me last year.

(goes up to window, looking sad)

In the end, everyone's leaving and
everyone is beginning new chapter of

DISSOLVE TO:

It's kind of cloudy in the morning, we see at the main gate the group of soldiers from Bravo-6 Team. As Dave puts his stuff in truck, he comes closer to his team.

DAVE

So, my team, my family, my Bravo-6 Team - with you I spent 10 amazing years and finally it came to an end. Now, it's my turn to choose next leader of this team and it will be the man who came up to me last night in my dorm while I was packing myself. Soldier Reigns. Will you come up here, please?

Everyone's cheering while soldier Reigns is coming to Dave. Dave smiles as Reigns comes.

DAVE (CONT'D)

ACT I

INT. AIRPORT - NIGHT

Less than 10 minutes, one young good-looking guy with his army suitcase is coming from department of arrivals. As he takes his glasses off, we see it's Dave Malkovich. He stops in middle of steps and decided to go to rent a car.

As he's approaching the rent-a-car desk, he takes out his personal documents.

DAVE

Good Evening! Can I rent a car please?

LADY

DAVE

CUT TO:

INT. HOTEL - CONTINUE

Interior of hotel is like house they don't have reception, but they do have one person who is main for welcoming guests and giving rooms. Dave approaches receptionist. The receptionist stands up and shake hands with him.

RECEPTIONIST

Good Evening, sir! Welcome to our beautiful hotel.

Dave thinks in himself.

DAVE

(voice over)

I wouldn't say it's beautiful but okay.

(to receptionist)

I would like to have one big apartment for tonight.

The receptionist shows him a catalog what options they have. It looks like they don't have all-inclusive nor continental breakfast. Dave looks carefully at catalog.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Sir, do you have any option with breakfast?

RECEPTIONIST

I'm afraid we don't, sir.

(pause)

but i think we can make exception only for tonight.

Dave smiles.

DAVE

Thank you very much, sir.

RECEPTIONIST

No worries. Let me see do we have
available apartment for you.

Receptionist checks laptop for available apartments. Dave
gets message from his former General Davidson.

GENERAL DAVIDSON

(message in phone)

Sgt. Malkovich, I hope you get home
safely. Yours General Davidson.

Dave looks at message and reply.

DAVE

(types the message)

Yes, I got home safely just now.
Thanks. Yours former Sgt. Malkovich.

At the same moment, the receptionist finds available
apartment and shows pictures to Dave.

RECEPTIONIST

Here's one which is currently
available. Its price is 25\$ per night.

On his face, we see he agrees with price of a apartment.

DAVE

Sure, I can go with this.

SLIDE TO:

INT. HOTEL APARTMENT - CONTINUE

As Dave enters in the hotel apartment, we see it's big
apartment with 3 bedrooms plus with 2 living rooms. He leaves
his bags at door and goes to living room. On his face, we see
that he's satisfied with apartment. Then, he sits on the sofa
in living room.

DAVE

Maybe this hotel isn't bad as it
looks.

Dave goes to pick up his luggage. Then, he goes to bedroom to
sleep.

FADE OUT:

INT. A CAR - DAY (MORNING)

The next day, Dave is already woken up and driving to shopping mall. While driving, he plays his favorite music song: Backstreet Boys - I want it that way. In middle of song, he gets a phone call from the Head of SPD. Dave accepts the phone call.

DAVE

Yes.

HEAD OF SPD

Mr. Malkovich will you please come to SPD?

DAVE

Can I know why?

HEAD OF SPD

It's about business. I'll be waiting for you at SPD station.

In that moment, the Head of SPD ends the call, so Dave changes his route to SPD station.

SLIDE UP:

INT. POLICE STATION - DAY (AFTERNOON)

In SPD station is very busy day, everyone is trying to get job done. We see Dave walks in station and goes to information desk to ask for the Head of SPD.

DAVE

Excuse me, sir

POLICE OFFICER 1

Yes, how can I help you?

DAVE

I'm here for Head of SPD. Could you please show me where is his office?

POLICE OFFICER 1

His office is on second floor.

DAVE

Thanks.

Dave leaves to elevator. He enters in the elevator and goes on 2nd floor. Then, he looks for office that it says "Head of SPD" and finally he finds it at end of hallway. Before he enters, he takes deep breath.

CUT TO:

INT. OFFICE - CONTINUE

As Dave enters, the Head of SPD stands up and welcome him. His office is small white modern office that it has coat of arms of Bosnia on the wall behind his desk. Then, on the right from desk is big window and on the window are pictures of his family.

Dave shakes his hands with him.

HEAD OF SPD

Welcome Mr. Malkovich. I'm very glad to see you.

DAVE

Thanks. I'm very glad to see you too.

The Head of SPD offers him a seat. He accepts it.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Could you please tell me about what did you called me for?

HEAD OF SPD

Sure. As you know, Bosnia has struggled past two decades ago with the amount of criminality. First, we had problems with war criminals, second, we had problems with the amount of crime, and that made me thinking what if we open task force which will serve for next level crimes such as terrorism, kidnapping, and mystery unsolved crimes. What do you think?

CUT TO:

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - CONTINUE

As they're entering in conference room, they see podium on the left side, and on the left side from podium is desk for the Head of SPD. On the right side from entrance, they are three rows with blue chairs. Dave goes and stand behind the podium with right hand raised, and the Head of SPD goes to sit behind the desk.

HEAD OF SPD

Mr. Malkovich, I need you to repeat after me.

DAVE

Yes, sir.

HEAD OF SPD

Then, let's begin.

Head of SPD starts to speak oath.

HEAD OF SPD (CONT'D)

On my honor, I will never betray my badge, my integrity, my character or the public trust.

DAVE

On my honor, I will never betray my badge, my integrity, my character or the public trust.

HEAD OF SPD

I will always have the courage to hold myself and others accountable for our actions.

DAVE

I will always have the courage to hold myself and others accountable for our actions.

HEAD OF SPD

I will always uphold the constitution, my community, and the agency I serve.

DAVE

I will always uphold the constitution, my community, and the agency I serve.

HEAD OF SPD

With this oath, I put Mr. Malkovich and the new task force into work.

Then the Head of SPD stands up and goes up to Dave. They hug each other. Next, Dave leaves to information desk to pick up his badge and weapon. After he takes his badge and weapon, the screen blurs slowly into black as Dave heads to exit.

ACT II

INT. COFFEE SHOP - DAY (AFTERNOON) AFTER A MONTH

In 10 minutes, we can see Jon Davis is entering the coffee shop and goes up to Dave. Dave stands up and hug him.

DAVE

Long time no see dude.

JON

Yeah, bro. I missed you so much.

They both sit down. Jon orders one mocha for him.

JON (CONT'D)

Where are you? -- We haven't see each other for years. How's life?

DAVE

I'm here now. I won't go back to U.S.

Jon looking surprised.

JON

Really? What happened that you're not coming back to U.S?

Dave gets closer to Jon over table.

DAVE

Basically, in order for me to stay in the Marines, I have to be American citizen, which they offered me already, but I felt I'm not ready to take it.

JON

How did you been all these years without?

Dave leans back to chair. The waiter brings Jon's coffee.

DAVE

Because during 9 years there was former general that I met once in Sarajevo, and then he got set up

somehow for me to stay. I have so much respect for that guy. Now, recent general has seen that I'm not U.S citizen and he wanted to make me U.S citizen.

Jon drinks coffee, followed by Dave.

JON

That's sucks dude. So, what are you doing now? - Do you have job?

DAVE

Yea, I do have job, the Head of SPD has offered me to run new task force and I accepted.

Jon looking happy for Dave.

JON

That's nice. What's capacity of the task force? - I mean how many people can be in it.

DAVE

The capacity is five people - so detective, commander, which is me, captain, police officer, and forensic officer - actual reason why am I called you here is about task force.

Jon looking kind of confused. Dave drinks coffee.

JON

What do you mean?

DAVE

I want you to become my partner.

While Jon is drinking coffee, he accidentally spills all over himself. Everyone in the coffee shop laugh.

JON

WHAAAAT?

The waiter comes to clean up and give Jon a tissue.

JON (CONT'D)

You want me for partner?

DAVE

(looks at bill)

Jon gives him 5\$ plus 2\$ for tip. Then they unite and leave coffee shop together.

INT. A CAR - DAY (AFTERNOON)

After a while, they're in the car, driving to Sarajevo City Center. During the driving, they talk their funny police stories.

JON

Dude, wanna hear my funny story as police officer before I became detective?

Dave agrees to hear.

DAVE

Sure.

Jon begins to tell his funny police story.

JON

So, one day I pulled over young lady, around - 18-20 years old, and I asked her, "Lady, it says in your driver's license that you should be wearing glasses." and then she said to me, "well I have contacts", and this is the funny part of me, " I don't care who you know! You're getting a ticket!"

Dave laughs.

DAVE

OMG, dude. Why did you said that?

Now, they hear from police radio that they need to chase a criminal car.

POLICE RADIO

Calling all units, a black suv with license plate "A06-A-029" at Dobrinjska street, Back-up needed, NOW!

Dave confirms.

DAVE

GERALD

Dave?

Dave looks confused.

DAVE

How do you know my name?

GERALD

You can't recognize me? Really? Do you remember when we tried out together for Bosnian military?

Dave still doesn't know him.

GERALD (CONT'D)

Generation 1992, class of 1993. We used to make fun of our teacher Mr. Fazlic.

Dave recognizes him,

DAVE

Are you Gerald the washer?

Gerald nods with his head.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Gerald from suburban part of the city. I can't believe it man, you have changed a lot since then.

GERALD

That's right my man. I'm changed man after something happened back in SPD.

Dave looking curiously.

DAVE

What happened bro? You know you can tell me everything.

Gerald agrees to tell Dave his story.

GERALD

Basically, I was accused of taking
bribe from drug dilers in order not to
arrest them, but this isn't true. --
Everything was setup by that asshole
Detective Williams.

DAVE

Okay, but do they know that he setup
everything.

GERALD

They didn't even let me to explain,the
head of SPD just sent letter of
suspension until further and that's
it.

Dave looking disappointed.

DAVE

I feel bad for you man, but I know how
I can help you.

Gerald looking curiously.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Would you wanna work in task force
with me?

GERALD

Ah dude, I don't know if I can be cop
anymore. What if SPD doesn't want to
see me wearing a badge?

DAVE

They do want you, because you're
innocent -

Gerald interrupts him.

GERALD

---they think I'm not, no one believes
me. I'm a sad man.

Gerald looking sad.

DAVE

--but I believe you -- we don't need
no one except us two. So, do you wanna

join in task force?

Gerald hardly accept.

GERALD

Hmm....O.K I'll be in your task force.

Dave becomes happy. They hug each other. Then Dave calls Jon to pick them up.

DAVE

Hey Jon, can you pick us up?

JON

(on phone call)

OK. I'll be there in 10 minutes.

DAVE

Thanks.

Jon ends phone call. They sit on the nearest bench. In 10 minutes, Jon arrives with a car. They get in a car and leave.

SLIDE TO:

INT. HEADQUARTER - DAY (AFTERNOON) - TWO WEEKS LATER

After two weeks, they all are meeting at headquarter of task force; inside of it, we can see it's modern headquarter: on the right side from entrance we see Dave's office and right across it's Jon's office. Then, as we're getting closer to the middle, we see on the left side one big monitor that it shows map of Bosnia and coat of arms of SPD. Next, we see Dave coming in with Jon and they are going to the middle.

DAVE

What's up?

JON

I'm fine. I got enough rest two weeks.

DAVE

That's good. This week is gonna be tough cause' I've already published advertisement for forensic officer and auditions are starting today from 4PM until 6PM

Gerald enters.

JON
That's awesome news.

Gerald greets them in a loud voice.

GERALD
Hey what's up? How's life?

Dave greets Gerald.

DAVE
We're fine. Could you please lower
your voice a little? That was loud by
the way

Gerald smiles. He agrees.

GERALD
Sure, no problem. So, what's the plan
for this week?

Dave pulls out advertisement on big monitor.

DAVE
I've published advertisement and today
we're expecting a thousand young
forensic students to show up on
auditions.

Gerald looks happy.

GERALD
Oh, that's great news. Are we gonna
test them individually when they show
up?

DAVE
Yes. Each of us are going to test in

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. HEADQUARTER - DAY (AFTERNOON) - LATER

As Jon is coming back to the HQ, he sees Dave and Gerald
together so he decided to approach them. They are talking as

Jon getting closer.

DAVE

--- he has been in jail for years. I'm hoping for him to stay there for life.

Jon gets closer.

JON

Who?

GERALD

Nothing important. Just some ex-fugitive that we discussed about.

JON

OK. So, are we ready for this?

(checks his watch)

It's almost 4PM

Dave checks his watch.

DAVE

Yes, we are. Now, let's everyone go in their offices and wait for any forensic students to show up.

Everyone nods with their heads and leave.

MONTAGE

-Jon, looking serious, is talking to a forensic student. On his face, we see that he is not happy with the client. He decides to test him by checking does the forensic student know how to use tool properly for opening body parts. The forensic student uses the tool completely wrong and almost stabs himself and then Jon takes the tool.

-In another office, we see Dave is testing other forensic student does she knows how to interpret with physical evidence. The forensic student takes practice evidence without gloves and in the background, we see Dave nodding his head off.

-In Gerald's office, we see that he's testing forensic student does he knows how to analyze the crime evidence. The forensic student takes his phone and takes photo of it and then present to Gerald. On his face, we see that he's totally disappointed.

BACK TO SCENE

As everyone comes out of their office, we see that they are disappointed.

JON
Dude, this audition went so bad.

GERALD
I know right.

JON
Dave? Can I ask you a question?

Dave accepts it.

DAVE
Sure.

JON
What age of requirement for forensic officer did you put on advertisement.

DAVE
I can't remember.

Jon pulls out advertisement on big screen. He zooms in to age requirement and we can see that age requirement is from 18-20 years-old.

JON
Now, I see why I had all young uneducated forensic officers.

Everyone looks at Dave with disappointment.

DAVE
What? How I could know that they just finished high school.

Dave pulls out the message from the head of SPD that it says that they don't need forensic officers, but if they want to, they can.

DAVE (CONT'D)
See this message from the head of SPD and this means we don't need forensic officer.

Everyone agrees.

DAVE (CONT'D)
Instead we can rent one small room in

the hospital where we would do any
crime analysis.

GERALD

That's good too.

JON

Alright guys. I'm leaving now.

Dave and Gerald say goodbye to Jon. Then, they're leaving to
Dave's office.

CUT TO:

EXT. STREET - DAWN

It's dawn and soon after Jon leave from the building he
decides to walk to home. As he walks, he's approaching one
small bus station and at the bus station, there is one
beautiful lady waiting for bus. Jon sees her and decided to
approach her.

JON

Excuse me, ma'am?

As the girl put her hair back, we see it's HEATHER GUTIERREZ,
a young forensic officer.

HEATHER

Yes.

(pause)

Wait a second. I know you

Jon looking confused.

JON

You know me?

HEATHER

Yes. You were that guy who always
trash talked about girls in the
university.

Jon looking confused.

JON

How do you know me, ma'am?

HEATHER

I was sophomore year when you
graduated from the University of

Sarajevo. Do you remember me now?

Jon starts to recognize her.

JON

Hmm...Are you Heather, the girl with funny curls?

Heather nods with her head. Jon clearly recognizes her.

JON (CONT'D)

Heather Gutierrez. I can't believe it that we met after 5 years ago. Have you graduated?

They hug.

HEATHER

Jon Davis. You stayed the same as in the university. Yes, I'm graduated and now I'm looking for a job.

JON

Time flies. What major have you been in?

HEATHER

I've finished for forensic scientist. Now, I'm looking to work in SPD, but they don't accept young ones.

Jon thinks.

JON

(voice over)
What if I offer her a job?
(to Heather)
Heather?

HEATHER

Yes.

JON

Would you like to work with me?

Heather looking confused.

HEATHER

Where do you work?

JON

I'm detective in task force and we filled all positions except one -- which is forensic officer.

Heather is in shock. She doesn't know what to say.

HEATHER

Really? I don't know what to say. What if I'm not ready for yet?

JON

You're ready and you were one of the best students in your major. Just say yes and tomorrow we'll go to meet other two members.

Heather looks around. She almost cries. She hugs him.

HEATHER
