JAMES

JAMES (CONT'D)

There is still no answer

FADE IN:

EXT. SPACE

SUPER: 2050

SCOTT is seen floating in the emptiness of space in a space suit. The voice on the radio becomes less and less clear until it fades into static.

THE VIEW STARTS TO CLOSE IN ON SCOTT

Scott is still floating and unconscious. The volume of the static goes down and eventually becomes silent.

THE VIEW SEIZES TO CLOSE IN

All of a sudden, Scott wakes up and starts coughing very strongly until he coughs up some blood. He looks down at his legs only to notice that his left leg is dislocated and just hanging awkwardly. He starts to wail in complaint

SCOTT

Oh Shit!

Scott continues to wail and is on the verge of crying when he starts to cough strongly again. He then looks around him and is relieved to see a small space station in the distance, which he starts making his way to.

CUT TO:

EXT. CALIFORNIA - NASA ROCKET LAUNCH - DAY - FLASHBACK

Two astronauts, Scott and James, are getting ready to get into a rocket. They have their helmets in hand and are adjusting their space suits

JAMES

Scott, you ready?

SCOTT

Yeah, just a bit nervous

JAMES

Don't be. It's just a quick job we gotta do. We'll be back before you know it

Scott takes a pocket watch out of his pocket and opens it. On it is the time and date, and on the inside of the cover is a picture of a woman in her late 20s. Then an OFFICER walks towards Scott and James

OFFICER

Ok boys, you ready?

JAMES

Yes sir

OFFICER

Then whatcha waitin' for? You boys are set to leave in 11 minutes!

Scott looks at the officer as he starts to make his way with James, into the shuttle and into the cockpit.

CUT TO:

CUT TO BLACK.

SCOTT

Hello?

There is no answer. He hits a button that activates gravity in the station. He falls to the floor and starts shouting in pain, looking at his leg that is still dislocated

SCOTT (CONT'D)

Anyone?

Still no answer. He starts to crawl his way through the space station and he reaches a chair which he lifts himself up into and sits down. He sighs a sigh of relief from his pain. Shortly after, he starts to cough strongly and his heart starts to palpitate. He starts to breathe heavily and his vision becomes slightly blurred. He looks around and sees a blood pressure monitor in the corner. He drops to the ground, shouting in pain, and then crawls his way over to the monitor. He then turns on the radio and all that can be heard it static. A signal is picked up but it is unclear and seems to be in another language. Confused, Scott tries to make contact with the person on the other end

SCOTT

Hello? Do you hear me?

There is still someone speaking on the other end but it is still unclear and Scott cannot understand anything

SCOTT (CONT'D) I need help! Do you copy? Over

Scott moans in frustration and turns the radio receiver off. Just as he does this, the Navigation System fully boots up and turns on. Scott opens the map to see where he is and notices something he doesn't understand

The map shows Scott's location and Scott zooms out only to find out that he is in a completely different Solar system. He is very confused because it's impossible that he could have ended up in another solar system within a day. He touches his face and looks at his arms and hands. Nothing seems to have changed much. He then remembers something
