INT. ELEVATOR. EVENING

VICTORIA

Hey Sarah, I know I'm late, uhm, Chinese is fine. Again, sorry
I'll make it to-

When

BOOM! A thunderous explosion shakes the elevator. VICTORIA gasps as the floor trembles beneath her. A deafening ring fills her ears. There's a sudden explosion. What the hell just happened? Was it a bomb? An earthquake?

The elevator blocks between 46 and 45 floors, and the emergency signal turns on.

VICTORIA falls on the floor, her phone slips from her hand.

The electricity goes off, while the emergency signal is still on.

VICTORIA CONT'D
This is unacceptable

The elevator is completely in the dark. VICTORIA's eyes struggle to adjust, but there's nothing to see. Her hands tremble as she fumbles for the phone in the dark. She finds it.

VICTORIA CONT'D Splendid

She uses her phone's torch to light around, until the backup generators are activated, the emergency signal goes off.

VICTORIA slowly rises to her feet. She turns off the light of her phone and she puts it back into her pants.

She moves to the door, she tries to open them but they are completely sealed and they do not open.

VICTORIA CONT'D

VICTORIA CONT'D Hello, is anybody here

No answer. She walks to the doors again, she hits them but no one seems to notice she's gone missing. Also, if there's been an explosion/earthquake why are the alarms not working?

VICTORIA tries to maintain her composure, but it's not easy, she takes deep breaths but she's sweating. She unbuttons the neck's button of her shirt.

VICTORIA pulls out her phone again and she sends another vocal text.

VICTORIA CONT'D

Sarah, it's me again, I think it might take a little longer than I thought

She realizes that this text and the previous one are not delivered, plus, the battery is running out of juice, it's at 12%.

When

Another explosion, the elevator plummets from floor 45 to 39. VICTORIA slams against the wall, gripping the handle, but it's useless. The impact sends her sprawling. Her head hits metal. Darkness swallows her hole.

END OF PROLOGUE

ACT ONE

INT. ELEVATOR. NIGHT

After what feels like an eternity, VICTORIA is still trapped inside.

Blood covers her left face due to the impact.

VICTORIA still lies on the floor, a deafening whistle fills her ears, she touches her face, she grimaces in pain. She finally opens her eyelids, everything's still blurred, she slowly sits against the wall, when she notices a woman dressed in total black standing before her.

VICTORIA gasps, afraid, she wants to scream but it's like she has lost her voice.

Woman

Are you hurt

VICTORIA tries to flatten against the wall, but given the small space... it's useless.

VICTORIA

Who... who are you

The woman kneels in front of VICTORIA, her motions are deliberately slow, maybe she doesn't want to scare VICTORIA, she doesn't seem to have bad intentions at the moment.

VICTORIA CONT'D

How did, how did you get in here

The woman indicates a hole on the ceiling, definitely big enough to get out of there. The hole in the ceiling is a jagged tear in the metal, edges sharp and glinting in the dim light. Twisted wires dangle from the opening, swaying gently. Looking up, Victoria could see only blackness.

VICTORIA CONT'D

Okay good so we can get out of here

VICTORIA tries to stand on her feet, but her head is pounding too much.

VICTORIA CONT'D

Damn it

She tries one more time, but she's too weak.

VICTORIA CONT'D Helping would be much appreciated

The woman ignores VICTORIA's request.

Woman How's the head

VICTORIA It hurts

The woman steps closer to VICTORIA, VICTORIA looks at the woman. It's like she's seeing herself in a mirror. The woman has the same features of VICTORIA, the only thing different is that her head is not bleeding, but there's a scar covering her left part of her face.

VICTORIA Who are you

Woman

VICTORIA

The woman stands up to her feet, she walks around the small place. Her walk is slow, every now and then she looks at VICTORIA, she is just trying to make her upset.

VICTORIA feels like an animal trapped in a cage, she looks around trying to find a potential weapon for personal defence, but there's nothing useful. With trembling hands she pulls out her phone, battery is still at 12%, but what's interesting is that it's 08.55 pm.

VICTORIA looks at the time again, she blinks her eyes repeatedly, but still, her phone indicates 08.55 pm. After everything that happened it's impossible that only eight minutes have gone by. She gently taps the phone against her leg but the time doesn't change. VICTORIA touches her chest, she listens at her heartbeat.

VICTORIA

Woman

Woman

Woman

Woman

VICTORIA

This is just a nightmare, you're not real

Woman

But I am real, I'm very real just... inside your head

The woman touches VICTORIA's cut on her forehead, then she takes a step back looking at VICTORIA.

The woman lights a cigarette, she offers one to VICTORIA.

Woman

Cigarette

VICTORIA

I quit

Woman

It won't last

The woman starts pacing around, VICTORIA can't move, she seems paralysed after what she just told her. Her face is whiter than a snowflake, her eyes are so wide open, she doesn't even blink them. She tries to move away from the door but her muscles are numb. She wants to take a step further but her feet are glued to the floor.

VICTORIA

Wait

The woman stops pacing right away. Her attention focused on $\operatorname{VICTORIA}$.

VICTORIA CONT'D
You just said you're just in my head right

Woman Yeah

VICTORIA

How do I get you out of my head

Woman

Oh sweetheart, you tell me

AKA there's no way out.

The woman smiles at VICTORIA, it seems an authentic one, even if her teeth are way too white almost disturbing.

VICTORIA's heartbeat is so fast, she can't breath, she's gasping for air, the woman stands in front of her, she's a bit disappointed by VICTORIA's reaction. She crosses her arm in protest while she shakes her head. VICTORIA gasps for air, she touches her neck, as if someone is choking her, she barely sits on the floor. VICTORIA looks at the woman, begging her to stop, she

VICTORIA Help... me

The woman just looks at her.

thinks she's the one who caused it.

VICTORIA CONT'D
Please

The woman raises her hand in resignation.

Woman So pathetic

VICTORIA unbuttons another button of her shirt.

VICTORIA 100, 99, 98, 9...97

The woman kneels in front of VICTORIA. Her eyes are fixed on her, unblinking, devoid of any warmth or emotion.

VICTORIA CONT'D 94, 93,

Woman

Brighton 2013

VICTORIA stops panicking, she stares at the woman in disbelief, her mouth is open for the shock.

VICTORIA

Woman

I told you, I know everything

The woman stares at her VICTORIA, she touches VICTORIA's face, briefly.

VICTORIA

Woman

VICTORIA

I quit smoking three years ago, expect for that one-

Woman

Time, while you were in Vegas

VICTORIA smirks.

VICTORIA

Right

VICTORIA CONT'D How do I get out of here

Woman

You just don't
VICTORIA

There must be a way

The woman shrugs, she gets up then she immediately sits again, this time, right next to her.

VICTORIA takes her phone back into her hand, she looks at the time it's still 08.55 pm.

VICTORIA is losing it, she looks at the screen and bursts out laughing, hysterically, nervously.

She looks at her phone one last time and she launches against the opposite wall, the phone hits the wall and then the ground. It smashes into little tiny pieces.

The woman looks at VICTORIA, tilts her head, is she sorry for her?.

VICTORIA turns and looks at her. For the first time VICTORIA gently touches the woman's arm.

VICTORIA Help me please

The woman smiles wholeheartedly.

Woman

Let's play a game

The woman stands up, happy and cheerful.

VICTORIA

I don't want to play with you!

The woman's look hardens instantly. She kneels down in front of VICTORIA, she puts her arm around VICTORIA's neck, choking her. VICTORIA gasps, she tries to stop her, but she is way more powerful than her.

Woman

You will play a game and you will like it

Woman CONT'D

VICTORIA

What if I refuse to answer

The woman looks around.

Woman

I guess we'll be stuck in here forever

VICTORIA swallows. The idea of being trapped in that elevator forever with that monster is too much. She takes a deep breath, and lights another cigarette.

VICTORIA Let's play

> Woman Yes!

The woman is so happy she jumps.

VICTORIA
Don't!

VICTORIA braces her arms around her legs, ready for the impact. The woman jumps a second time.
VICTORIA looks around, the elevator doesn't move.

VICTORIA CONT'D

I thought we would fall but it didn't, how's that possible

The woman shrugs, and helps VICTORIA stand on her feet. They face each other in the center of the elevator.

Woman Hands or eyes

> VICTORIA What

> > Woman

Come on VICTORIA! Pick something! It's not funny if you slow things down

VICTORIA Eyes

The woman nods appreciatively.

Woman

Let's start with something... simple

Woman CONT'D
Summer or winter

VICTORIA Winter

Woman

Right answer

VICTORIA is sweating, her forehead is pearly with drops of sweat and blood, the woman, on the contrary, is perfectly fine, she stands tall with her empty ice eyes looking at poor VICTORIA.

Woman

Dog or cat

VICTORIA

Both, but I slightly prefer dogs

The woman smiles, grateful for VICTORIA's honesty. Given the kind of questions, VICTORIA seems to ease herself a little bit.

Woman

Have you ever hurt someone

VICTORIA tenses, she bites her bottom lip. The questions are not as easy as the previous ones, the woman was just warming up, trying to make VICTORIA comfortable before making her uncomfortable again.

VICTORIA

Yes

Woman

When you look at yourself in the mirror, do you wish you're someone else

VICTORIA

Most of the time, yeah

Woman

Do you feel guilty

VICTORIA is a terrible liar, she looks on the ground.

VICTORIA

No

VICTORIA swallows.

The woman takes a step toward her.

Woman

My, my... You were doing great so far

VICTORIA takes a few steps back until she touches with her back the wall of the elevators.

Woman CONT'D

I thought we were bonding, for real

The woman walks until she touches VICTORIA's body, VICTORIA squeezes herself against the wall, she refuses to look at the woman, she turns her head on her right. The woman leans close to VICTORIA.

Woman CONT'D
This will hurt

VICTORIA

No, please, you don't have-

The woman keeps staring at VICTORIA with her blue iced eyes, and with the most serious look, she grabs VICTORIA's right hand. VICTORIA looks at the woman, with pleading eyes,

We hear a terrible noise, bone cracks. VICTORIA screams in pain, she moves away from the woman while she holds her right hand in pain.

VICTORIA CONT'D

You just broke my finger, you son of a bitch!

The woman takes a deep breath, she closes her eyes, her mouth is closed in a serious line, but she seems satisfied with what she just did. Slowly, she opens her eyes and turns to face VICTORIA.

Woman

I told you, don't lie to me

VICTORIA lights another cigarette.

VICTORIA

I'm done playing with you

She looks at her index fingers, and it's pretty bad.

Woman

Okay, but I'll ask you questions, after all, you still have nine fingers left

VICTORIA

You're sickening

Woman

I'm sure they told you so many times you don't count them anymore

VICTORIA

You tell me, you know everything

Woman

Brighton 2013

VICTORIA

I don't want to talk about it

Woman

Brighton 2013

VICTORIA

I'm done with you

Woman

Brighton 2013!

VICTORIA walks in front of the woman, she is upset, she is not sure if this is real or head is playing some dirty game, but she is tired of being trapped in the shit hole.

VICTORIA holds out her injured hand to the woman.

VICTORIA Break them

The woman still stands in front of her, but doesn't flinch, not even a bit.

VICTORIA CONT'D

You know what, I said eyes, so take it out before I do it

The woman doesn't move.

VICTORIA CONT'D

Fine

With a challenging look, VICTORIA meets the woman's gaze. Then, with a sickening squelch, she pushes her left thumb into her left eye socket.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

INT. ELEVATOR. NIGHT

The woman is sitting against the walls, VICTORIA is curled up against the woman's legs, unconscious, we don't see her face at the moment, the woman is stroking VICTORIA's hair.

VICTORIA suddenly jolts.

Woman

Finally, I thought you were dead

VICTORIA with her eyes still closed, and with an insecure and shaking hand, she touches her left eye, with sudden surprise, she realizes her eye is still intact. She opens them and she sits in front of the woman.

VICTORIA I can see

VICTORIA CONT'D
You... you helped me, why

Woman

I'm the one who makes the rules, and you don't get to break them

VICTORIA

Thanks, I guess

Woman

I won't be that lenient next time

VICTORIA Got it

The woman pulls VICTORIA in for a tight hug. VICTORIA, froze, her body stiff and resistant at first, but then she finds herself

hugging her back, after all she has got nothing left to lose, giving things if she could die right now it would be better.

They pull apart, but VICTORIA doesn't let her go.

VICTORIA CONT'D
You're... so beautiful

Woman

You are

VICTORIA raises her hand against the woman's face, but before touching her, she asks for her permission.

VICTORIA

Can I

The woman slightly nods, VICTORIA touches the scar on the woman's left face. The woman pretends to be fine, but when VICTORIA touches her skin she seems to be afraid her body is rigid, but then she seems to appreciate VICTORIA's touch.

VICTORIA CONT'D

Did it hurt

Woman

I... it's been a long time, I don't even remember it

VICTORIA

Were you alone when it happened

Woman

You and I, we always have been lonely, don't you think

VICTORIA

I like being alone

Woman

Do you, for real, or you just got used to it

VICTORIA

I guess I just got used to it

The light flickers before it dies for a second, when it goes on again the woman who has been torturing VICTORIA for all this time has finally gone, but she has been replaced by another woman, who sits right in front of her.

VICTORIA KATHERINE

KATHERINE VICTORIA

VICTORIA chuckles nervously.

VICTORIA

I can't believe it, this is my worst nightmare

KATHERINE

It's been a long time

VICTORIA

Yeah, since the divorce

KATHERINE

We never spoke since that

VICTORIA

Why would I, we have a lawyer, a real expansive one, best money ever spent

KATHERINE

You never change

KATHERINE CONT'D

We have a daughter, it would be nice if you could talk like two consenting adults

VICTORIA

I know we have a daughter, thank you for the reminder

KATHERINE

Sometimes it seems you forget you have one

VICTORIA takes a deep breath, she looks around and then she stands up on her feet.

VICTORIA

If this is one of your sick games, it's not funny

But of course, there's no answer back. Just the noise of the light.

KATHERINE

Who are you talking to

VICTORIA

No one

KATHERINE gets up, she walks right next to VICTORIA.

KATHERINE

What happened to your head, it seems pretty bad

VICTORIA touches her forehead.

VICTORIA

It's nothing

KATHERINE

Jesus, you can talk to me

VICTORIA lights another cigarette.

KATHERINE CONT'D
I thought you quit

VICTORIA

Yeah, I did

KATHERINE

And then what happened

VICTORIA

I started again

KATHERINE

Did you ever quit or was it just a lie like our marriage

VICTORIA

It wasn't a lie, I loved you

KATHERINE

You've been having an affair for two years, how can you say you really loved me

VICTORIA

We were unhappy

KATHERINE

Oh what was I supposed to do, I got home and saw you between someone else's leg

VICTORIA

I know and I told you I'm sorry, it just happened

VICTORIA CONT'D

Anyway, we're happier... divorced

KATHERINE

Says who

VICTORIA

I gave you everything you asked for, money, houses, cars, our daughter, everything

VICTORIA CONT'D

You took everything from me, including our dog

KATHERINE

It wasn't enough considering how you hurt us

KATHERINE CONT'D

How old was she

VICTORIA

22

KATHERINE

21

VICTORIA

Seems like you remember it way better than I do

KATHERINE

I remember it very well

VICTORIA

Listen, shut up and help me get out of here

VICTORIA walks closer to the nearest wall, she puts her face onto the wall, she wants to hear if there's someone else or something else beyond the walls.

KATHERINE

What are you doing, there's no one here

VICTORIA

There must be a way

She pulls away from the wall.

KATHERINE

Who are you dating now, anyway

Again, she's a terrible liar, she looks on the ground before answering.

VICTORIA

I'm not dating anyone

KATHERINE

You're still a bad liar

KATHERINE CONT'D

Plus, JOEY told me she saw you kissing a girl

VICTORIA

Her name's Sarah

KATHERINE

Is she young

VICTORIA

Very

KATHERINE

You never change

VICTORIA smirks.

KATHERINE CONT'D

Are you in love with her

VICTORIA shakes her head.

VICTORIA

Not really

KATHERINE

Does she know, have you been honest with her

VICTORIA

She knows I care about her, a lot

VICTORIA sits down on the floor, KATHERINE follows her, she sits right next to her.

KATHERINE touches VICTORIA's forehead, VICTORIA lingers under her touch.

KATHERINE

Let go VICTORIA, come on

VICTORIA

I'm tired, my heart hurts

KATHERINE

You just need to let go and everything will be over soon

KATHERINE CONT'D

You will not suffer anymore

VICTORIA puts her head on KATHERINE's shoulder.

VICTORIA

My head is spinning

KATHERINE cups VICTORIA's in her hands.

KATHERINE

Look at me, VICTORIA

VICTORIA meets her gaze with her.

VICTORIA

I think I need to lie down

KATHERINE gently shakes VICTORIA's face.

KATHERINE

VICTORIA stay with me, stay with me

VICTORIA

I just want to rest

KATHERINE

You will soon

KATHERINE CONT'D

You just need to tell me what happened

VICTORIA

What do you want to know, you already know it

KATHERINE

You know you can talk to me

VICTORIA

I just want to sleep

KATHERINE

You will, but first tell me what happened

VICTORIA

I... she was my colleague we were flirting for a while and it just happened-

KATHERINE

VICTORIA, VICTORIA stop

VICTORIA

What is it

KATHERINE

I already know about it

VICTORIA

I know

KATHERINE

I need to know what happened in Brighton 2013

VICTORIA stops abruptly, she grabs KATHERINE's hands while she looks right into her eyes.

VICTORIA

You're not KATHERINE

KATHERINE

Of course I am, who else would I be

KATHERINE CONT'D

VICTORIA, you're paranoid

VICTORIA

I know KATHERINE and she would never hurt me, she's not like me

KATHERINE

And I don't want to hurt you

VICTORIA

It's you, isn't it

KATHERINE

It's me KATHERINE

VICTORIA steps away from her.

VICTORIA

It's not you, I know it

VICTORIA

KATHERINE would never do something like that, even if I made her suffer a lot

KATHERINE

VICTORIA, please, we can work this out together

VICTORIA Stop it

KATHERINE

VICTORIA, I still love you, just talk to me

VICTORIA closes her eyes and covers her ears so she won't hear KATHERINE's voice anymore.

VICTORIA
Go away!

KATHERINE VICTORIA listen to me

VICTORIA

Stop it! Leave me alone!

She screams with all the strength she has left.

VICTORIA CONT'D
Leave me!

VICTORIA opens her eyes.

We see VICTORIA and the woman talking, while they sit on the floor.

Woman

Do you, for real, or you just got used to it

VICTORIA

I guess I just got used to it

The light flickers before it dies for a second, when it goes on again the woman is still sitting in front of VICTORIA.

VICTORIA looks around the room, what just happened? Was it a hallucination?

VICTORIA CONT'D What just happened

Woman

What are you talking about

VICTORIA

I was talking to you and then you were gone and, and, then I was talking to my ex wife KATHERINE

Woman

But I never left

Woman CONT'D

I stayed here with you the whole time

VICTORIA

You... you never left

Woman

I don't want to leave you

VICTORIA

Everybody leaves me, sooner or later

VICTORIA CONT'D
I push people away

Woman

I would never do that to you

The woman gently touches VICTORIA's face.

VICTORIA

You'll stay with me

The woman nods.

VICTORIA

Promise

Woman Promise

VICTORIA hugs the woman tight, the woman hugs her back. VICTORIA closes her eyes, she's tired. Instead, the woman's eyes do not show any compassion or sweetness, they are cold, determined, she did manage to drive VICTORIA crazy and now she can finally put an end to it.

Woman

We better do something, you're almost out of cigarettes

VICTORIA

We need to get out of here

VICTORIA CONT'D

I'm just so tired, I can't keep my eyes open

Woman

You can rest, I'll be right here

Woman CONT'D

VICTORIA, stop fighting, stop fighting me

With a shaky tone of voice.

VICTORIA

Woman

VICTORIA wants to answer but it seems like she can't say just "yes", it's like her voice doesn't let out of her mouth.

Woman CONT'D
Do you feel guilty

Woman CONT'D Who is AUDREY, VICTORIA

This time VICTORIA screams in rage, she screams so much her lungs burn. She has to breathe for a moment, before she starts talking. VICTORIA

Yes! Yes! I feel guilty

The woman stops spinning, she sits right in front of her. She did it, the woman broke her and she's ready to confess everything.

Woman

Better hurry up, we don't have much time left

The woman indicates the hole on the ceiling, if it was big enough to let her out, now it is reduced to a quarter of it.

VICTORIA takes a deep breath, after all what she has been through she is ready to talk.

The woman takes VICTORIA's hands in hers but she pulls back, the woman lifts an eyebrow but she doesn't push her further.

VICTORIA

AUDREY was... the love of my life

VICTORIA CONT'D

She was everything I wanted to be, funny, smart, generous. She was incredibly beautiful

VICTORIA wipes a tear away from her face.

VICTORIA CONT'D

We were spending our summer in Brighton, we were young, wasted and $$\operatorname{\mathsf{madly}}$ in love

Woman

Keep going, you're doing fine

VICTORIA

We decided to go clubbing, took some pills, but uhm, she-

Woman

She what VICTORIA

VICTORIA

She felt sick right away

VICTORIA looks at the ground not able to meet the woman's gaze.

 ${\tt VICTORIA~CONT'D}$

She overdosed

VICTORIA CONT'D

And she died alone, I was scared and I left her, to die alone

VICTORIA CONT'D

I run away like I alway do

VICTORIA CONT'D

I never loved anyone like her, I... barely survived ever since

Woman

I know

This time the woman's answer seems honest and sincere.

VICTORIA

I lied to you before, people don't leave me. I run away from them

Woman

I already knew it

The woman lights a cigarette, she offers one to VICTORIA and she lights it too.

VICTORIA

If you already knew, why you wanted me to say it

Woman

VICTORIA, my dear VICTORIA, it was time for you to let her go

VICTORIA

I can't

VICTORIA CONT'D

It's all my fault if she's dead. She had a bright future ahead and I took it away from her

Woman

Do you feel guilty

VICTORIA

Totally, it's all my fault

Woman

You know, as much as heartbreaking the story is, I'm not quite sure you told me everything

VICTORIA

I... I don't think I understand

The woman touches VICTORIA's chest until she makes her lie down on the floor, the woman crawls on her, they are face to face. The woman licks her neck.

VICTORIA is disgusted, she tries to move but the woman holds her steady.

VICTORIA

What are you doing

Woman

AUDREY was much more intelligent than you, she was the brilliant one, isn't it true

VICTORIA

Tr... true

Woman

What's the name of your company

VICTORIA

V&K

Woman

What do they stand for

VICTORIA

They are AUDREY's and mine last names

Woman

Remorse will eat you alive

Woman CONT'D

Look at the hole, VICTORIA, it's closing real fast

The hole is basically reduced to a few inches. VICTORIA jumps scared.

VICTORIA

We need to get out of here or we'll be stuck in here forever

Woman

Not yet

Woman CONT'D
Not so fast

VICTORIA

What more do you want

VICTORIA CONT'D
I lost, I told you the truth

Woman

Who gave the pills to AUDREY

VICTORIA

I paid a guy to mix them wrong for her

The woman whispers into her ear.

Woman

That's right, my pet

Woman CONT'D

You were so jealous you couldn't stand her anymore, she would have been the bright talented one and you would always have been second choice

VICTORIA

That's why I decided to-

VICTORIA/Woman Kill her

The hole closes for good. Now the ceiling is covered with grey metal walls.

The woman whispers into VICTORIA's ear.

Woman

Brace for the impact

VICTORIA and the woman hug themselves, just right before the elevator plummets from floor 39 and it stops in time before it smashes on the ground, the walls are still on but they are dented. However, the impact is still relevant, VICTORIA hits her head, she grimaces in pain and a trickle of blood comes out of her face.

VICTORIA

VICTORIA

VICTORIA

The woman stands on her feet, she helps VICTORIA to stand. It takes a while for VICTORIA to gain her balance again, she is cupping her head between her hands as if it is of any help.

Woman CONT'D

What if I tell bithet beyond that walls you could make it right

Woman CONT'D

Open the door and you'll find AUDREY waiting for you

VICTORIA

But I couldn't open them before

Woman CONT'D

Because you were lying to yourself

Woman CONT'D

This is your chance to make things right, come on VICTORIA, I know you want it too

Woman CONT'D

Do you want it VICTORIA

VICTORIA nods.

VICTORIA

More than everything.

Woman

Time to change your destiny

Woman CONT'D

Open this damned door and walk out, tell AUDREY how sorry you are

VICTORIA

Will you stay with me after

The woman takes VICTORIA's hand.

Woman

I'll always be with you, no matter what

Woman CONT'D

You have no idea how proud I am

VICTORIA nods to the woman, she walks toward the door, she hits it with her shoulder. Not the best move, the hit echoes inside her head, she stumbles, she has to hold her head as a disturbing whistle bursts inside her head.

Woman CONT'D
Don't give up now, VICTORIA

Woman CONT'D
You can do it!

VICTORIA wedges her fingers into the narrow gap between the door and the frame and pulls with all her might. VICTORIA screams in pain as her nails break, but this time she doesn't walk back, she keeps on pushing until...

The door slightly moves, there's a small ray of light coming from the other side of the elevator.

Woman CONT'D
You did it, VICTORIA! Keep going!

VICTORIA keeps pulling the door, and, finally, she opens the wall. A powerful light irradiates the room, the woman and VICTORIA have to step back because the light is too powerful, they cover their eyes as they have to adjust to the light.

VICTORIA
So what now

Woman

Now you get out

Angelic voice V.O.
VICTORIA

VICTORIA could recognise that voice between millions of people.

VICTORIA AUDREY, is that you

AUDREY
It's me

Paramedic V.O.

VICTORIA KENSINGTON, 43, she's under the effect of drugs. She crossed the street without looking and she was hit by a woman. CCTV shows the impact happened between 8.47 p.m. and 8.55 p.m.. the woman who hit her, AUDREY, is in the other room, she's in shock

Her nails are covered in blood and her right index finger is broken.

The woman looks at VICTORIA, her eyes are still cold.

Woman

VICTORIA, can you hear me

Woman CONT'D

I've got you, don't worry everything will be fine

VICTORIA whispering
I... found her

The woman leans close to her, she brushes a strand of blood matted hair from VICTORIA's face.

Woman

Then why do you look so lost

VICTORIA's eyelids flutter, as if she wants to answer, but before she can she closes her eyes.
