JOE

BROOKE

Phillip slowly turns to Brooke. He looks exhausted. He already knows he's about to start a fight. But can't stop himself.

PHILLIP

I'm not.

BROOKE

Dad, come on. Do this for me. I know you don't understand social media but just play along for me. We're going to vote all together, you've got to vote.

PHILLIP

I am voting.

BROOKE

OK.

PHILLIP

But I'm voting for Trump.

She lowers down her phone in disgust.

BROOKE

How the hell can I upload this now? You've ruined the video.

Joe reaches over to Brooke. Rubs her arm, trying to comfort her.

JOE

It's still three against one, don't get upset.

BROOKE

You can't say you're voting for Trump. Just say you're voting for Hilary like everyone else. Thousands of people are going to see this video. But no one is going to like it or share it if you're saying that.

MIRIAM

Come on Brooke, lets just go and get it over with.

BROOKE

JOE

EXT. CAR PARK - DAY

Brooke stands outside her parked up car. Covered in vote for Hilary merchandise.

She films herself with Joe and Miriam on either side of her. Phillip is no where to be seen.

Brooke cheers and screams.

BROOKE

Lets do this. Come on Hilary. Get out and vote everyone. Lets make sure the right person wins.

Joe and Miriam join in with her cheering and screaming.

BROOKE (CONT'D)

INT. VOTING BOOTH - DAY

CUT TO:
